

- Ke ano mai nei ka nahele, 'a'ohe manu o ke kula* (song), the forest is silent, there are no birds in the plains. *Ano wale mai nō kō aloha*, your love overpowers me. **hō.ano.** Holy, devoted to sacred use, hallowed, solemn; to reverence, sanctify, attribute divine honor, hallow. *Po'e Hōano o nā Lā Hope Nei*, Latter-Day Saints. *Hōano, Hōano, Hōano* (Hoik. 4.8), Holy, Holy, Holy. *E kō mākou Makua i loko o ka lani, e hōano 'ia kou inoa* (Mat. 6.9), our Father which art in Heaven, hallowed be Thy name. **2.** n. Time (in songs, and usually before *ahiahi*, rarely before *kaka-hiaka*).
- 'ano.** **1.** n. Kind, variety, nature, character, disposition, bearing, type, brand, likeness, sort, way, manner, shape, tendency, fashion, style, mode, circumstance, condition, resemblance, image, color, moral quality, denomination, meaning (preceded by *ke*). *Ke 'ano o ka nohona*, way of life, standard of living. *He aha ke 'ano?* What is [it] like [sometimes said scornfully]? What kind of nonsense is that? *He aha nō lā kou 'ano?* What's the matter with you? **hō.'ano.** To cause to take a definite shape, produce a resemblance. (PPN *kano*.) **2.** vs. Somewhat, rather; to show signs of. *'Ano maika'i*, somewhat good, pretty good, fair. *'Ano maika'i 'ole*, not very good. *'Ano 'ino*, wicked, disorderly (of conduct). *'Ano poepoe*, somewhat round. *Ke 'ano mālie mai nei*, beginning to clear up now. *E 'ano ua aku ana*, it looks like rain.
- 'ā.nō.** loc. n. Now, present. (Gram. 8.6.)
- anoa.** **1.** nvi. Dry, parched, barren. Same as *panoa*. **2.** Pas/imp. of *ano 1*. Rare.
- 'ā.noa.** vi. To end, give up.
- 'ano.'ai.** **1.** nvt. Greeting, salutation, news; to greet. *'Ano'ai kākou*, greetings (to more than two persons). *Nā 'ano'ai o Kona 'Ākau*, news of North Kona. **2.** vi. Unexpected. *'Ano'ai kō māua hui 'ana*, our meeting was unexpected. **3.** part. Perhaps. *'Ano'ai aia paha i laila ka hale noho a ka 'i'ini* (chant for Ka-lā-kaua), perhaps there the dwelling house of desire.
- 'ano akua.** nvs. Godlike, divine; godly form.
- ano.ano.** Redup. of *ano 1*. *Kula anoano kanaka 'ole*, solitary uninhabited plain. **ho'āno.ano.** Redup. of *ho'āno*. *Ho'ānoano wale mai nō mehe haili lā e kau iho maluna*, awe-struck as though a spirit has descended from above. *I Wai-lua ā ho'ānoano ka ihu o ka wa'a* (GP 62), [turn] the prow of the canoe to Wai-lua and place under taboo.
- 'ano.'ano.** n. Seed, kernel, germ; dried and salted Chinese watermelon seed. *Fig.*, progeny, offspring.
- 'ano 'ō.** vs. Strange, odd, unusual, uncommon, grotesque, peculiar, eccentric, freakish, queer, quaint, different, uncomfortable. **hō.'ano 'ō.** Caus/sim. *Hō'ano 'ē iki a'e kona helehelena*, and altered his features.
- ano.hale.** n. Individual presiding over the 'ume game. (Malo 215.)
- 'ano hana.** n. Method, case, technique, as in solving problems.
- 'ā.noho.** n. Sitting taboo. (Kep. 137.)
- 'ano hou.** nvs. New variety, fashion, or kind; new, unusual. **hō.'ano hou.** To renew, change the nature or character.
- 'ano hui.** n. Compound, as of fractions.
- 'ano hui.kau.** vs. Complex, as of fractions.
- 'ano'i.** nvt. Desire, longing, love, desired one, lover (see ex., *pouli 1*); to desire, yearn; loved, beloved. *'Ano'i pua*, cherished flower, sweetheart. *'Ano'i ka mana'o*, hope. *Ka mele i 'ano'i nui 'ia*, the greatly beloved song. *'Ano'i aku e 'ike iāia*, great desire to see her.
- 'ano lani.** vs. Of heavenly or royal character, celestial, noble, royal, pure.
- 'ano like.** nvs. Resembling, of similar nature or type; resemblance, similarity. *Nā mea 'ano like 'ole*, assortment, miscellany.
- 'ā.nona.nona.** Same as *naonao* and *nonanona*, ant. *E hele 'oe i ka 'ānonanona, e nānā i kona 'ao'ao e ho'ona'auao iho* (Sol. 6.6), go to the ant, study her ways and learn. The newspaper *Ka Nonanona* (1841-5) was named for this saying.
- 'ā.noni.** vt. To mix, interweave, intertwine, mixed. *Fig.*, confused, doubtful. *Koko 'ānoni*, mixed blood. *'Ānoni 'ia me ke koko Pākē*, mixed with Chinese blood. *'Ānoni ka mana'o*, a confused, doubting mind. (PCP *kaanoni*.)
- 'ano.nia.** **1.** Pas/imp. of *'ānoni*. **2.** Same as *alani wai*, a plant.
- 'ā.noni.noni.** Redup. of *'ānoni*, perplexity.
- 'ano.noni.** Same as *'ānoninoni*.
- 'ano nui.** nvs. Important, vital, main; importance. *Mea 'ano nui*, important person, loved one, V.I.P., celebrity.
- 'ano 'ole.** nvs. Insignificant, trivial, of no consequence, unattractive; nonsense. *He wahi kumu 'ano 'ole, 'o ka huhū nō ia*, it was such a trifling reason for anger.
- 'ano pili.** n. Property, as of a number; fraction.
- anu.** nvs. **1.** Cool, cold; coolness, temperature. *Nu'uanu* (place name), cool elevation. **ho'ānu.** To cool. (PCP *anu*.) **2.** nvi. Cold, influenza; to have a cold. *Ua loa'a i ke anu*, to get a cold.
- 'anu'a.** n. Heap, mass, pile.
- anu.anu.** Redup. of *anu*, cold; chilly. **ho'ānu.anu.** Caus/sim.
- ā.nuē.nuē.** **1.** nvi. Rainbow. *E wai ānuenuē ana nā wāwae o nā koa*, the feet of the soldiers form a rainbow pattern [of marching soldiers in colored uniforms]. (PNP *nuanua*.) **2.** n. Scallop-like design on tapa and tapa beater.
- 'anuho.** n. Caterpillar. Also called *'enuhe, nuhe*. (PPN *'anufe*.)
- anu.heā.** nvs. Cool, soft fragrance, as of upland forests; sweetness; to be cool, fragrant, and sweet. Also *waiānuhea*. *Kō 'ala anuheā ka'u i honi aku* (song), your cool soft fragrance I inhaled.
- 'ā.nuho.nuho.** **1.** vs. Infested with caterpillars. **2.** vi. Wrinkled, furrowed; to pucker, wrinkle, shrivel. **3.** Var. name for *nenue* fish. (AP.)
- 'anu.iki, 'anuiti.** n. Annuity. *Eng.*
- 'ā.nulu, 'ānunu.** Variants of *'ālunu*, greed. *Palapala 'ānunu me ka pākaha* (song Elbert and Mahoe 63), greedy document of extortion.
- 'ā.nunu.** n. A native genus of cucurbit vines (*Sicyos*). (Neal 808.) Cf. *kūpala*.
- 'anu'u.** **1.** n. Stairs, jogs, steps, terrace, dais, ledge (1 Nal. 6.6). **2.** n. Tower in ancient heiau, about 7 m high and 5.5 m square, as enclosed with white 'ōloa tapa. Cf. *nu'u 1*. **3.** nvi. Sprain, strain, disjuncted vertebra; to stumble, trip, sprain; to land heavily or jar, as when one steps down but there is no step; jarred. *Fig.*, error, slip; to err. Cf. *māui*. **4.** n. A step between two notes on a musical staff. *Pili 'anu'u*, to go up an interval (in music). **5.** Noun indicating comparison of adjectives. *'Anu'u kumu*, basic stage. *'Anu'u waena*, comparative degree. *'Anu'u loa*, superlative degree.
- 'anu'u hapa.** n. Half-step in music.
- 'anu'u maoli.** n. Full step in music.
- 'anu'u hapa a me nā 'anu'u maoli.** n. An augmented second in music.
- 'ā.nu'u.nu'u.** vi. Having steps; wavy, curly, vibrating, undulating; to beat with regular rhythm; to jerk the body, as by osteopaths or masseurs. *Alapi'i 'ānu-'unu'u*, stairs. **ho'ā.nu'u.nu'u.** To vibrate, undulate, wave, jerk, make steps; wavy, as hair. *Leo ho'ānu-'unu'u*, quavering, trilling voice.
- ao.** **1.** nvi. Light, day, daylight, dawn; to dawn, grow light; enlightened; to regain consciousness. Cf. *aokanaka*. *Piliwawai lākou ā ao ka pō*, they gambled until night became day [all night long, until dawn]. *Kelā pō ā ao a'e i nehinei*, night before last; *lit.*, that night that dawned yesterday. *Ā ao ka pō ā pō ke ao*, when night becomes day until the day becomes night [for a night and a day]. *Ua ao mai ka no'ono'o*, the mind is functioning. **ho'āo.** (a) To marry; marriage (old term, probably *lit.*, to stay until daylight). (b) (*Cap.*) Night of
