

In causative/simulative forms beginning with ho-, hō-, ho'-, or hō', delete the prefix and look for the stem.

- (song), let's turn the nose of the horse toward the candlelit grove. (PPN *foaki*, PCP *soo*: cf. Penrhyn *soo*, Yasuda 15.) 2. vi. To wheeze, breathe hard. 3. n. Hoe, colter of a plow. Eng. *Me kāna hō, a me kāna ko'ilipi* (1 Sam. 13.20, with his colter and his axe).
- ho-**. Marker of the caus/sim.; same as *ho'o-*, but commonly found before words beginning with a glottal stop followed by a long vowel, as *'āpuka, ho'āpuka*.
- hō-**. Caus/sim. marker before glottal stop and short vowel or before long vowel or vowels, as *'ike, hō'ike, 'ā, hō'ā, hō'ā'ā*. Gram. 6.4.
- ho'-**. Marker of the caus/sim.; same as *ho'o-*, but commonly found before words beginning with *a-* or *e-* (or sometimes *i-*), with lengthening of the first vowel of the word, as *ano, ho'āno; emi, ho'ēmi; inu, ho'īnu*, or before words beginning with a long vowel, as *ō, ho'ō*.
- hō'-**. Marker of the caus/sim.; same as *ho'o-*; occasionally found before words beginning with *i-*, as *ikaika, hō'ikaika*.
- hoa**. 1. n. Companion, friend, associate, colleague, comrade, partner, mate, peer, fellow, antagonist (if followed by a word such as *kaua* or *paio*). Cf. *hoahānau, hoa hele, hoaloha, hoa paio*, and saying, *cold 1. Kona hoa, his friend. Hoa o ka Hale o nā Lunamaka'āinana*, member of the House of Representatives. **ho'o.hoa**. To make friends. (PPN *soa*.) 2. nvt. To tie, bind, secure, rig; rigging, lashing. See *hoa wa'a*. 3. nvt. To strike with a stick or club; to club; a club. (PPN *foa*.) 4. Same as *mamo 1*, the honey-creeper.
- hoa, ho'o.hoa**. To challenge, dare, provoke; daring, defiant. Cf. *uahoā. Ho'ohoa nā manu hanina*, the quiet birds are daring. *Hana ka iwi a kanaka makua, ho'ohoa mai*, get maturity into the bones before issuing a challenge.
- hō.ā**. 1. vt. To set on fire, burn, ignite, etc. See *'ā 1*. 2. vt. To drive, as cattle or fish; to herd. See *-ā*. 3. vi. To talk much. See *ā 1*. 4. See *hō'ā ipuka hale*.
- hō.ā'a**. See *a'a 1*, root, vein, etc.
- hō.ā'ā**. vt. To kindle, light. See *'ā'ā 1*.
- hō.ā'ā**. vi. To blunder, stray. See *'ā'ā*, demented.
- hō.ā'ahi**. v. To kindle fire.
- hō.ā'ahu**. vt. To clothe. See *'ā'ahu*.
- hoa'ai**. Eating or dinner companion.
- hoa'āina**. n. Tenant, caretaker, as on a *kuleana*. *Ou po'e hoa'āina* (FS 141), your tenants.
- hō.ā'aka**. vs. Surly. See *'ā'aka 1*.
- hoa ali'i**. n. Companion of a chief, fellow chief, chief descended from the god Kāne (For. 6:266). *Fig.*, the gods.
- hoa aloha**. Var. spelling of *hoaloha*.
- hō.ā'ā maka**. v. To stare, etc. See *'ā'ā maka*.
- hō.ā'ano**. vt. To boast, defy. See *'ā'ano*.
- hō.ā'apu**. See *'ā'apu*.
- hō.ā'e**. 1. vt. To make fine, soft. See *'ae 3*. 2. vi. To rise. See *'ae 4*.
- hō.ā'ē**. vt. To break taboo. See *'ā'ē*.
- hō.ā'e'a**. vt. To cause to wander. See *'ae'a*.
- ho'āe.āe**. n. A chant with lengthened vowels. See *aeae*.
- hō.āha**. vt. To braid. See *'āha 2*.
- hō.āha.āha**. Same as *'āha'āha 2*.
- hoa hana**. n. Fellow worker, colleague, partner, accomplice.
- hoahā.nau**. n. Cousin; brother or sister, as a church member. *Kona hoahānau*, his cousin. *Hoahānau Kami-ka*, Smith Brothers [as the name of a firm].
- hoa hanauna**. n. Relative of one's own generation.
- hoa hau.mana**. n. Schoolmate.
- hoa hele**. n. Traveling companion, fellow traveler. (In Iosua 14.8 "*ko'u hoa hele*" seems to be the Hawaiian translation of "my brethren.")
- ho'ā.hewa**. vt. To blame, condemn. See *'āhewa*.
- ho'āhi.ahi**. See *ahiahi*, evening.
- ho'āho**. See *aho*, breath.
- hō.āho**. See *'aho*, thatch.
- hoa.hoa**. Redup. of *hoa 3*; a rounded tapa beater (also called *hohoa, pepehi*); rapid beating, striking, as of tapa or pandanus leaves; a stick beater for washing clothes. *Fig.*, bad-tempered. *Keu ho'i kēia a ke kanaka hoahoa*, this person certainly beats the beater [in rage].
- ho'o.hoa.hoa**. Caus/sim.
- hoa.hoaka**. 1. Redup. of *hoaka 3-5*. 2. n. Comb of a rooster.
- hoa.holo.moku**. n. Shipmate.
- ho'āho.nui**. See *ahonui*.
- ho'āhu**. vt. To collect, pile. See *ahu*.
- hoa.hui**. n. Associate.
- hoai**. n. Joining, suture, joint. *Rare*. Cf. *hoa 2*, and below.
- hō.āi**. vt. To feed. See *'ai*, food.
- hō.āi.ā**. See *'ai'ē*.
- hoai kala**. n. Lambdoidal suture.
- hoai kau.paku**. n. Sagittal suture.
- hoa ikū**. Similar to *hoa ali'i*. (PH 53, 65.)
- hō.āi.lona**. See *'ailona*.
- hō.āi.lona.lana.kila**. n. Sign or emblem of victory. See *'ailona*.
- hoai maha**. n. Temporal suture.
- hoai manawa**. n. Coronal suture.
- hoa'inau**. n. Sweetheart, mate, spouse.
- hō.ā ipuka hale**. Same as *hoaka ipuka hale*.
- hoaka**. 1. n. Crescent; arch, as over door of ancient house (Kep. 101); crescent-shaped design at base of temple drum; crest, as on a helmet. 2. (*Cap.*) n. Second day of the month. (Kep. 101.) (PCP (*F,S*)*oata*, cf. *Easter o'ata*.) 3. nvi. Brightness; shining, glittering, splendid; to glitter, shine, flash as lightning, become daylight; to flame. *Fig.*, glory. Also *'oaka. Lele hoaka*, to fly glittering, as fire sparks. (PCP (*f,s*)*oata*.) 4. v. To cast a shadow; to brandish, as a spear (2 Sam. 23.18), to drive away, ward off, frighten. Cf. *aka 1. Mai hele ma'ō e hoaka ai i ke kai o holo ka i'a*, don't go over there and cast your shadow in the sea lest the fish run away. 5. vt. To open, as the mouth. (Hoik. 13.6.) 6. n. Spirit, apparition, ghost (For. 6:370). *Lele ka hoaka*, the spirit has flown [of death; the glory of the land has departed]. 7. n. Disease of the abdomen, perhaps appendicitis, rupture (followed by a qualifier). See *hoaka ipuka hale, hoaka kākala*. Other qualifiers reported are *hāwele, kū, kū kahi, kū lua*.
- hō.āka**. See *'aka*, to laugh.
- ho'ā.kaaka, hoakaka**. vt. To clarify. See *akaaka*, clear.
- hō.āka.āka**. See *'aka'aka*, to laugh.
- ho'ā.kahelo**. See *akahelo*.
- hoaka ipuka hale**. n. Ruptured appendix, appendicitis (not certain).
- hoaka kā.kala**. n. A disease (ruptured appendix?).
- hoaka.kala**. n. 1. Bracelet of tusks of hog or dog. 2. Same as *hoaka kākala*.
- hoa kā.kau**. Coauthor, writing associate.
- hoaka.ke'a**. n. Arch over a door, lintel.
- hoa kā.ko'o**. n. Ally, supporter.
- hoa kama.li'i**. n. Childhood playmate.
- hoa kanaka**. n. Fellow man. *E'ike iā kāua hoa kanaka, o kipa hewa ke aloha i ka 'Ilio* (chant), recognize us [who are] fellow men, lest love be wasted on a dog.
- hoa kaua**. n. Fellow soldier, enemy.
- hoa kā.unu**. n. Lover, delightful companion.
- ho'ā.kēa**. See *ākea*.
- hō.āki**. See *'aki*, to nip.
- ho'ā.koa.koa**. See *'ākoakoa*.
- hoa kua**. n. Companion of a god, godly companion.
- hoa kū.kā, hoa kū.kā.kū.kā**. n. Consultant, counselor, adviser, one with whom one confers and deliberates. *Kona hoa kūkākūkā* (Rom. 11.34), his counselor.
- hoa kula**. n. Schoolmate.
