

- name), the new spring. (PPN *fo'ou*.) 2. vs. Again, more, re- (as in *ho'oponopono hou*, re-edit). *Hana hou*, do again, repeat; encore. 3. vt. To push, thrust, poke, stab, shove, prick, plunge, ram, jab, drill, bore, pierce, inject. See also *houhou*. *Hou kui*, injection needle. *Ka hou 'ana o ka ihe* (FS 55), the hurling of the spear. (PPN *fohu*.) 4. nvi. Perspiration, sweat; to perspire, sweat. (PCP (*f,s*)*ou*.) 5. n. Varieties of wrasse (*Thalassoma*) shallow-water fish, as *T. purpureum*. The following names have been recorded for the young stages of the *hou*: 'āwela, kanaloa, 'ōlali, 'ōlani, pāhouhou, pākaiete, pākaueloa, palae'a, pā'ou'ou. 6. Same as *pakaweli*, a variety of sugar cane.
- hō.ū.** vi. To grunt. See 'ū 1.
- hou.hēwa.** vi. To turn this way and that, as in panic.
- hou.hou.** Redup. of *hou* 3. *Fig.*, to make cutting or cruel remarks. *Ka makani houhou 'ili* (song), the wind that makes the skin tingle. (PEP *foufou*.)
- hou kui.** See *hou* 3.
- hō.ulu.ulu.** See 'ulu'ulu, collection.
- hō.una.** n. Scooping. See 'upena hōuna.
- hou pahi.** v. To stab with a knife.
- houpo.** n. Diaphragm, chest, solar plexus. *Lelele ka houpo i ka 'oli'oli*, the heart leaps for joy. *Pa'a ka houpo*, the stomach is full. *Houpo lewalewa*, sagging chest [hunger]. (PCP (*f,s*)*oupo*: cf. Tuamotu *houpo*.)
- houpo 'ume pau.** n. Strong pulsation in solar plexis, heart attack.
- hou puka.** v. To drill a hole, bore or pierce through.
- hō.wai.** vs. Watery, as thin poi; soggy. *Pā hōwai*, a dish containing liquids.
- hō.wai-a-ulu.** n. A perennial herb (*Lagenophora mauiensis*), found only in marshy high parts of West Maui. The leaves form a basal rosette, from which rises a stalk bearing a round daisy-like flower head with yellow center and white rays.
- hū.** 1. nvi. To rise or swell, as yeast or souring poi; to ferment, leaven, overflow (Isa. 8.7), percolate, effervesce, boil over; to surge or rise to the surface, as emotion; to gush forth; rising, swelling, outburst. Cf. *hua'i*. *Perena hū 'ole*, unleavened bread. *Hū ka 'aka*, to burst into laughter, guffaw. *Hū ka pele*, to pour forth lava, erupt. *Inā hū aku kou 'uhane i ka po'e pōloli* (Isa. 58.10), if your soul has compassion for the hungry people. *Hū mai ke aloha no ka 'āina*, love for the homeland swells forth. *He hū wale mehe wai lā* (Kin. 49.4), unstable as water. **ho'o.hū.** To leaven, cause to rise, inflate, swell, overflow; yeast, baking powder. 2. vi. and interj. To roar, grunt, hum, whistle; huh (interj.)! *Hū ka makani*, the wind whistles or roars [of things going at great speed]. *Hū wawā ka nahele*, din roaring in the forest [gossip]. (PPN *fuu*.) 3. n. A spinning top. *Hū oeo*, humming top. *Kaula hū*, cord used to spin a top. *Ho'oniniu i ka hū*, to spin a top. 4. vi. To depart from the proper course, miss the way. *Hū ā pua'a*, off the course like a pig [of one who does not follow a straight and narrow path, as of a drunkard]. **ho'o.hū.** To cause someone to deviate from the path; to shoo, drive away, rout. 5. n. Gum, as of the 'ōlapa tree. 6. n. Commoners as a mass. *Ē ka hū*, *ē ka maka'āinana*, *aloha 'oukou* (chant by Ka-māmalu bidding farewell to Hawai'i), O commoners, O citizenry, farewell to you. 7. Var. of *hui* 2, to unite, join. *Ē Lono*, *e hū 'ia mai ka lani me ka honua* (prayer), O Lono, join heaven and earth.
- hua.** 1. nvi. Fruit, tuber, egg, produce, yield, ovum, seed, grain, offspring; meat as in 'opihi shell or 'alamihī crab; to bear fruit, tuber or seed; to bear a child; fruitful. For kinds of eggs, see *hua 'alu'alu*, *huamakani*, *hua moa*. *Hua mo'a loa*, hard-boiled egg. *Hua mo'a hapa*, soft-boiled egg. *Hua 'ai*, fruit. *Hua kanu*, seed. *Ā e hana aku 'oe iā 'oukou e hua a'e* (Oihk. 26.9), and will make you fruitful. **ho'o.hua.** To bear fruit, reproduce, produce, yield; to sire or give birth; to swell high, as a wave (UL 36). *Nalu ho'ohua*, a swelling wave. *Ho'ohua kawowo*, a medicine for women to induce conception. (PPN *fua*.) 2. n. Round object, as pill or bead. Cf. *huaale*. 3. n. Result, effect; credit, as for a university course. *Ka hua o kā 'oukou hana*, the result of your work. **ho'o.hua.** To have as a result, because of, ever since (followed by *nō*). *Ho'ohua nō ka make 'ana o ka makua kāne*, *pau kō mākou 'ike 'ana iāia*, ever since his father's death, we've never seen him again. *Ho'ohua nō i ka huhū 'ana o ke kupuna*, 'o ka hele nō ia, because of his grandparent's anger, he departed. 4. n. Testicles. *Ka hele ā pala nā hua i ka moana*, testicles rot at sea [a sailor lacks a sex partner]. *He hua pēpē 'ia* (Oihk. 21.20), broken testicles. (PNP *fua*.) 5. Same as *huahua* 3, a vulgar gesture. *Ho'opu'u ka hua*, to make this gesture. 6. nvi. Word, letter, figure, watchword, rallying cry, note in music; winning word in the Chinese gambling game of *chee-fah*; type; to speak. Cf. *hua helu*, *hua 'ōlelo*. *Ho'onoho hua*, to set type. *Kāne kū i ke kala*, *kala i ka hua o ka waha* (prayer), Kāne stand to forgive, forgive the words of the mouth. *Ā hua* (For. 5:43), then speak [cf. *pane* I]. (PPN *fua*.) 7. (*Cap.*) n. Name of the thirteenth night of the lunar month. (Malo 35.) (PEP (*f,s*)*ua*.) *Kapu Hua*, monthly taboo nights of Mōhalu and Hua. 8. (*Cap.*) Name of a star. 9. n. The bulging of the broadest part of a paddle blade. 10. See *pai hua*. 11. See *pa'i hua*.
- huā, huwā.** nvi. Envy, jealousy; envious, jealous; to stir up trouble due to envy. Cf. *māhuā*. **ho'o.huā.** To provoke anger or jealousy. (PPN *hua'a*.)
- hu'a.** n. 1. Foam, froth, bubble, suds, scum. *Hu'a o ka wai*, water bubble. (PCP (*f,s*)*uka*.) 2. Rim, border, edge, side, hem; ruffles and tucks at the bottom of a dress; tucks in a mat; train of a gown. See *mānele hu'a ho'ohiwahiwa*. *Ākea ka hu'a o ka lōle*, the bottom of the dress is wide [a full skirt]. *Ka hu'a o ka lā'au* (FS 99), the reach of the club. 3. Suburb, boundary. 4. Pile, as of mats or tapa. (For. 4:63.) Also *nu'a*. 5. Same as *ma'a* 4.
- hu'a. ho'o.hu'a.** To insist, persist. *Ho'ohu'a noho'i i ka inu lama*, persisting in drinking intoxicants.
- hua.ā.** vs. Very sour, of poi.
- hū.ā.ā.** vi. To burn intensely.
- hua 'ai.** n. Edible fruit or seed. *Hua 'ai mālili* (Kanl. 28.22), blasted fruit.
- hua.āla.** n. Nutmeg, spice. *Lit.*, fragrant fruit.
- hua ala.ka'i.** n. A leading note in music, the major seventh of any scale, a semitone below the tonic.
- hua.ale.** n. Pill, tablet. *Lit.*, seed to swallow.
- hua.ale ho'o.moe.** n. Sleeping tablet.
- hua 'alo.** n. Missing letter.
- hua 'alu.ālu.** n. Egg with a very soft shell.
- hua 'ā.lua.lua.** See 'ālua 2.
- hua ani.ani.** n. Glass bead.
- hua 'ē.** n. Child born out of wedlock, that is accepted by the husband or wife of the parent and treated as his own. *Lit.*, strange fruit. *Ka'ā*.
- huā.elo.** Var. spelling of *hua āelo*. See *āelo*.
- hua hapa.** n. Half note, as in music.
- hua hapa.hā.** n. Quarter note, as in music.
- hua hā.ule.** nvs. Fallen fruit or seed. *Fig.*, friendless, uncared for by parents or chief; bastard, illegitimate child (modern); foetus lost through miscarriage.
- hua hā.ule wale.** Same as *hua hā.ule*. Also said of a sweet potato produced from the extended vine as distinguished from the product in the hill.
- hua.hekili.** n. 1. Hail. *Lit.*, thunder fruit. (Puk. 9.18.) 2. Rare name for the beach *naupaka* (*Scaevola*) plant.
- hua.hekili uka.** n. A small native *naupaka* (*Scaevola kilaueae*) found only on dry lava near Kī-lau-ea Volcano. It does not exceed a height of 80 cm, has narrow, thick leaves, dull-yellow flowers, and small black fruits that were used to dye tapa. Also *papa'ahékili*. (Neal 819-20.)
- hua helu.** n. 1. Figure, number (the character). 2. A few, little. *'Ehia āu lei? He mau hua helu nō*. How many leis for sale have you? Just a few. *He wahi hua helu ia*, it's of some help [financial].
- hua hō.āi.lona.** n. Abbreviation.
- hua ho'o.ne'e.** n. Combination, as of a safe. *Lit.*, number to make move.
