

hua ho'o.noho. n. Type.

hua.hua. 1. vi. Fruitful, productive, prolific; to bear many fruits; to lay many eggs. (PPN *fuafua*.) 2. Testicles. See insult, *lo'a'a . . . kau*. 3. n. A vulgar gesture of contempt made by thrusting the thumb between index and middle fingers with the fist clenched, or the fist held up to the face and the eyelid drawn down. With the gesture one sometimes said, "*Eia kau 'o ka huahua*," "Here's your *huahua* gesture."

ho'o.hua.hua. To make the *huahua* gesture.

huā.huā, huāhuā. Redup. of *huā*. See ex., *pe'a 1*, For. 4:129, 131. *Ā huāhuā maila kō Pilisetia iāia* (Kin. 26.14), and the Philistines envied him.

hu'a.hu'a. 1. Redup. of *hu'a 1*; foam, froth, lather, bubbling, frothing. *Ua lo'ohia 'oia e kekahi 'uhane, auē koke nō ia . . . ā hu'ahu'a a'e* (Luka 9.39), a spirit seizes him, and he suddenly cried out . . . until [he] foams. **ho'o.hu'ahu'a.** Caus/sim. Rare. (PCP (*f,s*)*juka(f,s)juka*; perhaps PEP.) 2. n. Jelly. Rare. 3. See *hu'ahu'a kai*.

hua.hua'i. Redup. of *hua'i*; to boil up, as water in a spring; to gush forth, effervesce; culmination of sexual passion. *Kāua i ka huahua'i, e 'uhene lā i pili ko'olua* (song, UL 166), we two in passionate outpour, giggling, clinging two and two.

hu'a.hu'a kai. n. 1. Sponge *A ho'oma'u i ka hu'ahu'a kai i ka vinega* (Mar. 15.36), and soaked a sponge with vinegar. 2. Sea foam; crest of a wave breaking into foam. 3. A variety of seaweed.

hu'a.hu'a.kō. n. A coarse, weedy native dock (*Rumex albescens*) in the buckwheat family. See also *pāwale*.

hu'a.hu'a kopa (sopa). n. Soapsuds.

hu'a.hu'a lana. n. Floating froth. *Fig.*, an ignoramus.

hua.hua.lau. nvt. Interrogation to incriminate, ensnare, or obtain information by roundabout methods, to question or quiz indirectly. **ho'o.hua.hua.lau.** Caus/sim.; to cross-examine. (Kin. 42.7.) *Na'u na'e i ho'ohuahualau aku, ā no laila, hū mai ko'u aloha* (Laie 607), I used devious methods and then my love poured forth. *Ua ho'ohuahualau mai ia iā mākou me kāna 'ōlelo 'ino'ino* (3 Ioane 10), he prattles against us with his evil words.

hua.huwā. Var. spelling of *huāhuā*.

hū.ai, hū.wai. n. 1. A shellfish of the *hīhīwai* family. 2. A kind of seaweed (*Codium*).

hua'i. vt. To disclose, reveal, uncover, as an oven; to disinter, dig up, pour forth, break forth; to churn water, as a ship propeller (*hū 1 + -a'i*, transitivizer: Gram. 6.6.4). Cf. *po'o hua'i. Ke lepo ke kumu wai, e hua'i ana ka lepo i kai*, when the source of water is dirty, dirt is seen in the lowlands [one with dirty thoughts hears dirty words].

hua iki. n. Small letter, small fruit.

hua.'ina. nvi. Boiling up, opening, uncovering; to gush forth, as lava.

huaka. 1. vs. Clear as crystal, bright, dazzling, white, shining, flashing. **ho'o.huaka.** To cause a gleam of light, flash, glimmer. 2. n. Shadow, reflection. **ho'o.huaka.** To cast a shadow or reflection.

hua kahi. n. An only child or offspring. (PPN *fuatasi*.)

hua kai. n. Scrambled eggs.

hu'a kai. n. Sponge, foam.

hua.ka'i. nvi. Trip, voyage, journey, mission, procession, parade; to travel, parade. Cf. *ka'i*, to lead. *Ua huli a'e nā huaka'i* (Ioba 6.18), the caravans turn aside.

hua.ka'i hele. nvi. Travels, a long trip; to keep traveling.

hua.ka'i ho'o.hano.hano. n. Honor escort.

hua.ka'i ka'a.hele. nvi. Tour; to make a tour.

hua.ka'i pō. n. Night procession or parade, especially the night procession of ghosts that is sometimes called *'oi'o*.

hua kala.kala. n. Bur.

-hua kama. ho'o.hua kama. To sire a child.

hua kani. n. Tone in music.

hua kanu. n. Seed, as of mango; bulb.

hu'a kapa. n. Pile of tapas. See *hu'a 4*.

hu'a kapu. n. Taboo borders, as of a taboo place, or of the taboo enclosure where hula was taught.

-hua.kawowo. ho'o.hua.kawowo. To induce pregnancy.

hua.kē. vs. Full and plump, as a healthy person; well-proportioned, as a properly built canoe.

-huake'eo, -huake'o, ho'o.hua.ke'eo. Hurt, angry, displeased, resentful. Also *ho'okuake'eo, ka'eo, ho'o-ke'eo, ho'oke'eke'e*.

hua kē.pau. n. Printer's type. See ex., *'ōniu 3*.

hū ā keu. vs. Excessive. *Hū ā keu i ka 'ino*, extremely wicked.

hua kinoko, huakineto. n. Jacinth. (Hoik. 21.20.)

hua kō.kua. n. Grace note in music.

hu'a kopa. n. Soap bubble.

hū ā kū. Same as *hū ā keu*. *He 'ōlelo hū ā kū i ka pono*, a word completely just.

hua kukaima, hua kudaima. n. Mandrake. (Kin. 30.14.) (Hebrew *dudoim*.)

hua kukui. n. *Kukui* (candlenut) nuts. *Hua kukui ka i'a*, the fish resemble *kukui* nuts [describing schools of fish with noses protruding from the water].

hua kumu. n. Alphabet. *Lit.*, basic letters.

hū.ala.kē. vs. Loose; to tie loosely; round, full, swelling; to sag, as cheeks.

hua.lala. vs. Curved, warped, oval, twisted.

hua.lani. n. A variety of sweet potato.

hua.lani. n. Offspring of a chief.

hua.lau. n. A variety of banana. *Lit.*, many fruits.

huāle. Var. spelling of *huaale*.

hua.lele. n. 1. Seeds of the *laulele* plant. 2. Hernia. *Lit.*, flying testicles.

hua leo hui. See *hua palapala leo hui*.

hua leo kahi. See *hua palapala leo kahi*.

hu'a.lepo. vi. To scatter dust, especially a method of fighting with a club or spear in which the opponent was blinded by stirring up dust; to hit an underhanded blow. Also *hu'elepō. Wili a'ela 'o Pūpū-ākea i kāna lā'au, a hu'alepo akula ma nā wāwae o Maka-kū-i-kalāni* (For. 4:349), Pūpū-ākea twirled his club and scattered dust at the feet of Maka-kū-i-kalāni.

hua lewa. n. *'Ōhi'a* or *'ōhi'a 'ai* fruit used as medicine (Kam. 64:103, 141); perhaps also a kind of wood.

huali. vs. Bright, polished, clean, pure, white, glittering, gleaming; morally pure. *Ua huali kona kapa e like me ka hau* (Mat. 28.3), his raiment was white as snow.

ho'o.huali. Caus/sim.; to polish (Ezek. 21.10). *Mehe 'ōlinolino lā ke nānā aku, a me ke keleawe ho'ohuali 'ia* (Ezek. 8.2), like the brightness of the sun to look upon, and gleaming bronze.

hua li'i. 1. nvs. Small or inferior fruit; runt; small, puny. 2. n. Small letter.

hua li'i.li'i. 1. n. Berry. 2. nvs. Grace note in music.

hua lili. n. Blasted fruit.

hua loa'a. n. Product, answer, as in arithmetic.

hu'a lole. n. Trimmings or borders of a garment; hem of a dress.

hū.'alu. n. Loose skin over the eyeball; slight viscous membrane covering the eye.

hua.lua. See *mai'a hua lua*.

hua.lū.kini. n. Musk, as used in making perfume. See *wai Lūkini*.

hua mā.hoe. n. A two-note chord.

hua-mai-lani. Same as *kūkaekua*. *Lit.*, fruit from heaven.

hua.makani. n. Tiny, yolkless egg. *Lit.*, wind egg.

hua mele. n. Notes in music; words of a song.

hua.moa. n. 1. Round-ended bone entering the hip socket. 2. Type of house with thatch purlins separated by a width of three fingers. (For. 5:645.) 3. Same as *moa*, a native variety of banana. 4. A variety of sweet potato.

hua moa. n. Chicken egg. (PPN *fua moa*.)

hu'a moena. n. Pile of mats. (For. 4:63.)

hua mua. n. 1. Offering to a Congregational church of
