

- Hui.hui-kō.kō-a-Maka.li'i-kau-i-luna.** n. A name for Pleiades. *Lit.*, Makali'i's net hanging above. (HM 368.)
- hui.hui.maka.li'i.** n. A kind of seaweed.
- hui.huini.** Redup. of *huini* 1, 2.
- hui'ia.** vs. Incorporated, united, joined.
- huika, huīta.** n. Wheat. *Eng. Palaoa o ka huīta* (Puk. 29.2), wheat flour.
- hui.kahi.** vs. 1. United in one; in accord and agreement. 2. Girded in *malo* or *pā'ū* tightly fastened with a single hitch.
- hui.ka'i.** vt. To mix or jumble, make disagreeing statements, put several stories into one. (*hui* 2 + *-ka'i*, transitivizer; cf. Gram. 6.6.4.)
- hui.kala.** nvt. To absolve entirely, forgive all faults, excuse, cleanse and purify morally; pardon, atonement, absolution; ceremonial cleansing. Cf. Malo 199. *E huīkala 'oukou iā 'oukou iho* (Oihk. 20.7), sanctify yourselves.
- hui.kā.lēpa.** n. Trading company, mercantile firm.
- hui.kau.** nvs. Mixed, confused, haphazard, blurred; mix-up, confusion, jumble; to mix. *Huīkau ka makau a ka lawai'a*, the fisherman's hook is tangled [of confusion]. **ho'o.hui.kau.** Caus/sim., to mix, confuse, complicate, perplex, scramble.
- Hui Ke'a 'Ula.'ula.** n. Red Cross.
- hui.kinai.ahi.** n. Fire department.
- huila.** 1. Rare var. of *uila*. *Huila nā pū*, the guns flashed. See ex., *'api'api* 3. 2. n. Wheel. *Eng. Ke 'ano o nā huila* (Ezek. 1.16), the appearance of the wheels.
- huila.kau.like.** n. Disc wheel of a sewing machine.
- huila.makani.** n. Pinwheel. *Lit.*, wind wheel.
- huila.niho.niho.** n. Stitch regulator of a sewing machine.
- huila.nūi.** n. Large wheel; flywheel, as of a sewing machine.
- huila.palala, huilapalela.** n. Wheelbarrow. *Eng.*
- huila.pō.niu.niu.** Same as *ka'a pōniuniu*, Ferris wheel.
- huila.wai.** n. Water wheel, windmill.
- hu'i.lēle.** n. Darting pain. (Kam 64:108.)
- hui.malū.** nvi. Any secret society or fraternity, as the Masons; Masonic; to meet secretly.
- Hui Moku Holo Pili.'āina.** n. Inter-Island Steam Navigation Company.
- Hui Moku.lēle Pili.'āina.** n. Inter-Island Airways Company.
- huina.** n. 1. Sum, total, amount. (2 Sam. 24.9.) *E ho'oku'i i ka huina*, add up the total. *Ho'oku'i i ka huina o lākou me nā mamo a Isera'ela* (Nah. 1.49), add up a census of them among the descendants of Israel. 2. Unit, cluster; military detail or detachment. *Ka huina lawe hae*, color detachment, color-bearing unit. 3. Angle; corner, as of a house or street; crossroads, intersection, junction, juncture. 4. Tie or slur (music).
- huina-**. Geometric figure. See *huinahā*, *huinakolu*, and others.
- huina.ala.nui.** n. Crossroads, street corner.
- huina.hā.** n. Quadrangle, quadrilateral.
- huina.hā.hiō.** n. Figure with four equal sides but oblique angles, rhombus.
- huina.hā.hiō.lō.'ihi.** n. Oblique parallelogram.
- huina.hā.kau.like.** n. Square.
- huina.hā.like.** n. Square. *Lit.*, equal square.
- huina.hā.like'ole.** n. Quadrangle with unequal sides.
- huina.hā.loa.** n. Rectangle.
- huina.hā.lua.like.** n. Quadrangle with only two sides parallel, trapezoid.
- huina.hā.pā.'ani.** n. Children's blocks.
- huina.helu.** n. 1. Sum of several numbers, total. *Huina helu 'oko'a* (Nah. 14.29), the whole number, sum total. 2. General arithmetic.
- huina.hiku.** n. Heptagon.
- huina.koho.** n. Purchase price, as at an auction.
- huina.kolu.** n. Triangle.
- huina.kolu'ao.'ao.like'ole.** n. Irregular triangle.
- huina.kolu'elua'ao.'ao.like.** n. Isosceles triangle.
- huina.kolu.kū.pono.** n. Right-angle triangle.
- huina.kolu.like.** n. Equilateral triangle.
- huina.kolu'oi.** n. Acute triangle.
- huina.kolu.pelē.lēu.** n. Obtuse triangle.
- huina.kū.pono.** n. Right angle.
- huina.lā.'au.lana.** n. Raft. (1 Nal. 5.9). *Lit.*, collection of floating logs.
- huina.lima.** n. 1. Pentagon. 2. Joining of two hands, especially in hand wrestling (*uma*).
- huina.loa'a.** n. Gross profit.
- huina'oi.** n. Acute angle.
- huina.ono.** n. Hexagon.
- huina.papa.lana.** n. Raft. *Lit.*, collection of floating boards.
- huina.pelē.lēu.** n. Obtuse angle.
- huina.pū.kuni.ahi.** n. Battery (artillery).
- huina.wai.** n. Pool, meeting place of two or more streams. *Ma nā loko, a ma nā huinawai apau* (Puk. 7.19), over the ponds and all the pools of water.
- huina.waina.** n. Cluster of grapes.
- huina.walu.** n. Octagon.
- huini.** 1. vs. Needle-pointed, sharp-pointed. **ho'o.huini.** To carve or sharpen into a point. 2. nvi. Sharp, shrill sounds; to make such shrill cries. 3. n. Wooden peg used in mending bowls. Also *kui lā'au*.
- hui o Papa.** n. Chorus of Papa, a prayer for the purification of women uttered in the early morning at the *Hale o Papa*, house of Papa, a temple reserved for women.
- huipa.** 1. n. Kind of hard, black stone used for *maika* stones. 2. nvi. Whip; to whip. *Eng.*
- hui.pā'a.** n. Syntax. *Loina huipa'a*, rules of syntax.
- hui.pū.** n. Conjunction (the part of speech).
- hui.pū.** vt. To mix, unite, blend, assemble, combine, mingle. See *'Amelika Huipū 'Ia. Hui pū 'ia*, united, joined.
- hui.puhi'ohē.** n. Band.
- hui.pu'u.** n. Type of *pā'ū* (no data).
- hui'uwī.wai.ū.** n. Dairy.
- huka.** 1. nvt. Hook, as on a door, shoes, clothes; to hook. *Eng.* 2. Advice, information. (And.) 3. A balm. (And.)
- hū.kā.** vt. To guzzle and gobble, as a hog; a call to hogs to come. *Hūkā noho'i ka 'ai 'ana*, such hoglike gobbling.
- hū.kā'a.** n. Pitch, resin, gum from a tree; resinous timber drifting to Hawai'i from the northwest coast of America.
- huka.hukā.** Redup. of *huka*.
- huka.hū.kai.** vs. Somewhat insipid, brackish. See *hūkā-kai*.
- hū.kai.** Same as *hūkākai*.
- hū.kai.kai.** Rare var. of *hūkākai*.
- hukai.loloa.** One who has long served a chief. (And.)
- hū.kā.kai.** 1. vs. Insipid, tasteless, bland, as food or poi made of immature taro; brackish. Also *'ōkākai*. 2. Same as *'u'ulukai*, bloated.
- huka.pihī.** nv. Buttonhook; to hook a button.
- hū.kē.** vt. To blow the nose. Also *ho'okē*.
- Huke.kona, Hudesona.** n. Hudson, as the river or bay. *Eng.*
- hū.keu.** n. Bulge, cheek of the buttocks.
- huki.** 1. vt. To pull or tug, as on a rope; to draw, stretch, reach; to support, as a political party. See ex., below. *Huki i luna*, to pull up, hoist. *O huki mamuli o kona 'ao'ao*, lest preference be shown to his side. *Huki i ka lani, ka lae o Ka-lā'au* (chant by Hi'iaka), reaching to the sky is point Ka-lā'au. **ho'o.huki.** Caus/sim.; to pull gently. (PPN futi.) 2. nvi. A fit of any kind, convulsion, stroke, spasm, epileptic fit; twitching, cramp, as in the leg; to have a fit or cramp. Cf. *huki leo pa'a*. 3. nvi. A hula step: one foot steps to the side, the other foot is pulled toward it so that the heels almost touch, and then is taken to the opposite side. 4. vs. Soft, tender, as cooked meat that pulls apart when picked up. 5. vs. Twisted, drawn at the mouth, as a result of illness.
