

- own bones [take care of your own interests]. *Kō kō iwi 'āina hānau*, your own land of birth (PPN *iwi*.) 2. Shell, as of coconut, candlenut, gourd, egg, shellfish. Cf. *iwi hala*. 3. Remnants, pieces, as of coral in a lime pit after lime is extracted by burning, or as pieces of broken glass. 4. Corncob. 5. Stones or earth ridge marking land boundary. 6. Long line, as of surf. 7. Midrib, as of *pili* grass or ti leaf.
- 'iwi**. 1. Var. of *'i'iwi*, a bird; considered by some an *'aumakua*. (PCP *kiwi*.) 2. nvs. Reddish. 3. n. Twitching of the eye, sometimes accompanied by contraction of the mouth. **hō.'iwi**. Caus/sim. (PPN *kiwi*.)
- iwi ā**. n. Jawbone. *Ka iwi ā o ka hoki* (Lunk. 15.15), jawbone of an ass.
- iwi akua**. n. A deified bone of an ancestor, an *unihipili*. **ho'o.iwi akua**. To impart mana to a human bone.
- iwi 'ao.'ao**. n. 1. Rib, rib bone, spareribs. (2 Sam. 2.23.) 2. Wife (so-called because Eve is said to have been taken from Adam's rib); assistant leader in a hula troupe. Also *paepae*.
- iwi 'aui**. n. Sprain.
- iwi elelo**. n. Hyoid bone at the base of the tongue. *Lit.*, tongue bone.
- iwi hala**. n. Hard, upper part of pandanus key.
- iwi hilo**. n. Thighbone, femur, the last rib bone; poetically the very core of one's being. *Konikoni ana i ka iwi hilo*, throbbing to the very depths of the chest.
- iwi hoe.hoe**. n. Shoulder blade.
- iwi honua**. n. Rock or shoal projecting on a coral reef. (UL 61.) *Lit.*, earth shell.
- iwi hope**. n. Bone forming the posterior segment of the skull.
- iwi hua**. n. Hipbone; round bone fitting into a socket.
- iwiwi**. nvs. Bony, skinny, emaciated. (PPN *iwiwi*.)
- iwi kā**. n. Ischium, seat bone; spines on a fish fin.
- iwi ka'ele**. n. Keel, as of a ship.
- iwi kala**. Same as *iwi ka'ele*; spines on fish fins.
- iwi kala kua**. n. Spines on dorsal fins of fish.
- iwi kā lalo**. n. Spines on ventral fins of fish.
- iwi kamumu**. n. Cartilage. Also *iwi kumumumu*.
- iwi kanaka**. n. Human bone or skeleton.
- iwi kā.nana**. n. Bone of the anterior part of the skull, forming the skeleton of the forehead.
- iwi kani**. nvs. Strong bones; possessing strong bones, strength. *E hana paha 'oe a iwi kani, i kohu ai kāu kaena iho* (song), you should, perhaps, have strong bones to match your boasting.
- iwi kano**. n. Preaxial bone of the forearm.
- iwi-kau-i-ka-ua**. n. Name of a star and of an ancient chief of Hawai'i.
- iwi kele**. Same as *iwi ka'ele*.
- iwi koko**. See *iwi I*.
- iwi-ko'o**. n. Name of a *lua* stroke.
- iwi.kū**. n. Bone of the lower leg.
- iwi.kua.mo'o**. n. 1. Spine, backbone. 2. Near and trusted relative of a chief who attended to his personal needs and possessions, and executed private orders; family. *Ho'i hou i ka iwikuamo'o*, return to the family [as after long absence or estrangement].
- iwi kumu.mumu**. See *kumumumu*.
- iwi lā.T**. n. Stem and midrib of a ti leaf.
- iwi.lei**. n. 1. Collarbone. (PNP *iwilei*.) 2. Measure of length from the collarbone to the tip of the middle finger with the arm extended; yard. (PNP *iwilei*.)
- iwi loa**. n. A tall bone. *Fig.*, a tall person.
- iwi 'ō**. n. Wishbone.
- iwi.ole**. n. Kind of adze. *Lit.*, fang bone.
- iwi 'ō.pe'a.pe'a**. n. Two bones between the occipital and frontal bones forming a part of the top and sides of the cranium; parietal bone.
- iwi pā.uma**. n. Breastbone, as of a fowl.
- iwi pili**. n. 1. Midrib of a blade of *pili* grass. 2. Double or united bone of arm of leg.
- iwi po'i**. n. Kneecap.
- 'iwi pō.lena**. Same as *'i'iwi pōlena*, a honey creeper.
- iwi pona**. n. Hollow bone, as the eye socket; socket at a joint into which a round end of a bone fits.
- iwi po'o**. n. Skull, head bone; leader (*rare*). *Ka-iwi-po'o*, Calvary (partial loan translation of Latin *calvaria*, bare skull).
- iwi pū.haka**. n. Pelvic bone.
- iwi-puhi**. n. Design on a tapa beater and on tapa consisting of a herringbone figure with a long ridge in the center; design in plaited hat braids, as forming the *pāpale 'ie*. *Lit.*, eel bone.
- iwi pū.niu**. n. Coconut shell. *Fig.*, skull.
- iwi uluna**. n. Humerus or bone of the upper arm. *Lit.*, pillow bone.
- iwi umauma**. n. Breastbone, sternum.
