

cluck. *He nahenahe ma kekahi wahi, ā he kīkīko'u ma kekahi wahi o ka mele*, soft in some places, deep-toned in other parts of the chant. **2.** Redup. of *kīko'u*.

kikila. n. Kettle. *Eng.*

kikila kī. n. Teakettle, teapot. *Eng.*

kikili. Redup. of *kili 1, 2*.

Kiki.lia, Sikilia. nvs. Sicily; Sicilian. *Eng.*

kikilo. nvs. Distant time, either in the remote past or future; far in time or distance. Cf. *kilo*. *I kikilo aku i nā mamo*, way in the future to the descendants.

kiki.loa. Var. of *kikilo*.

kī.kī.lona. vi. To incite. *Rare.*

-kikilua. ho'o.kiki.lua. In the card game high-low-jack-and-the-game, to hide one's strength and then play a winning card.

kikima, sitima. n. Acacia (RSV), shittah (KJV). (Isa. 41.19.) (Probably Heb. *shittim*.)

kikimo. Redup. of *kimo 2*.

kikina. n. **1.** Urging, insistence. Cf. *ho'okina. Kō kikina ua laki* (chant), your insistence has good luck. **ho'o.kikina**. Redup. of *ho'okina*. **2.** Season. *Eng.*

Kiki.nō, Sidine. Sydney. *Eng.*

kiki'o. **1.** nvi. Settling of water in pools or puddles; to settle. **2.** Redup. of *ki'o 2*. (PNP *titiko*.)

kikipa. Redup. of *kipa 1, 2*.

kī.kī.pala.pala. n. A variety of taro.

kī.kī.pani. **1.** n. Conclusion, last, end, every last one. **2.** nvi. Severe stomach pains that make breathing difficult; to endure such. *'A'ole nō he nahu maoli o kona 'ōpū ā kīkīpani ho'i i kona houpo*, it was not a normal ache in his stomach, but a pain that made breathing difficult. *E noho maila i loko o ka hau'oli . . . ua wehe 'ia ke kīkīpani o ka makemake*, living happily . . . every desire satisfied.

kī.kī'ula. n. Name of a star. *Lit.*, red emitting.

kiki wai. v. To shoot water with a hose or water pistol, to hose. Cf. *ho'okahe wai*, to let water run in irrigation. *Pā kiki wai*, water pistol.

kikiwi. vi. Bent or curved, as a bird beak; humped; to bend or bow the head; to stagger forward, to weave along as a drunk. Cf. *'i'iwī, kiwi. Ihu kikiwi*, hooked nose; curved beak.

kiko. **1.** nvt. Dot, point, spot, speck of any kind; section of a story; cock or trigger of a gun (see ex., *ala 2*); punctuation mark; dot in music indicating time added to a note, also to repeat; dotted, speckled, spotted; to dot, mark, peck, hatch; to pick up food, as chickens; to injure fruit, as by a fruit fly; tattooed with dots on the forehead. *Ke a'o 'ana i ke kau 'ana i nā kiko*, instruction in the placing of punctuation marks. **ho'o.kiko**. To hatch. (PCP *tito*.) **2.** n. Taboo mark consisting of two crossed ti leaves held in place by a pebble. (PH 123.) **3.** vi. To draw or guess the winning number in *chee-fah*, a Chinese gambling game. *He aha ka hua i kiko mai nei?* What word was guessed correctly [in *chee-fah*]? **4.** n. Thin end of a fish pole.

kikoa. Pas/imp. of *kiko 1*. *Kikoa nā lae o nā kāne*, the foreheads of the men were tattoo-dotted.

kī.kohō. Var. of *kīkahō 1, 2*.

kiko ho'ōho. n. Exclamation mark.

kiko ho'o.maha. n. Punctuation mark indicative of a pause, as comma, colon, semicolon, period. *Lit.*, resting punctuation mark.

kī.kohu. nvt. Spots, stains, blemishes; to stain, spot [contraction of *kiko* and *kohu*]. *Kīkohu 'ia me ka 'ula'ula*, spotted with red.

kiko hua. Same as *kikokiko hua*.

kī.kohu.kohu. Redup. of *kīkohu*.

kī.koi. vi. **1.** Rude, sarcastic. *I pane kīkoi mai ai* (FS 239), answered rudely. **2.** To do in irregular, haphazard fashion, as skipping about while reading; irregular. *Mahi kīkoi*, to farm scattered unsystematic patches, rather than a complete patch.

kiko kahi. n. Period mark in punctuation. *Lit.*, single dot.

kiko.kiko. nvt. **1.** Dotted, spotted, speckled, as a pig; to

dot frequently; to discolor with spots; to nibble, as fish at bait; to peck repeatedly, as a feeding hen. (PCP *titotito*.) **2.** To type.

kiko.kiko hua. nv. To typewrite; typist. Cf. *mīkini kiko-kiko hua*.

kiko.kikoi. Redup. of *kīkoi 1, 2*.

kiko koma. n. Semicolon. *Lit.*, dot comma. *Eng.*

kiko.lā. n. Timekeeper. *Lit.*, day marker.

kiko.luko. vt. Colored in stripes; to mark in long parallel lines in a variety of colors.

kī.komo. **1.** vt. To inlay; to mix, as sap from tree-fern fronds (*palaholo*) and *māmaki* bark with *wauke* bark while beating tapa. **2.** n. Pole fishing in shallow sea.

kiko moa. nv. Term of reproach for commoners committing incest (perhaps a post-Christian term). *Lit.*, hatch like chickens.

kiko moe. n. Hyphen. *Lit.*, supine mark.

kikona, disona. n. Ibex (RSV), pygarg (KJV). (Kanl. 14.5.) (Heb. *dison*.)

kī.konī. nvt. Small adze used for smoothing and finishing a canoe; to smooth and finish a canoe; to soften *wauke* bark for tapa making; to pierce or lance a swelling; to peck; to blaze, as a tree; a piercing, peck, blaze; to rap on the forehead, usually with a single knuckle, especially as a gesture of rudeness or contempt, hence to treat contemptuously. Cf. *kīkēkē*, to rap with all the knuckles. *Ka 'ai kīkonī a nā manu*, peck eating of the birds.

kiko.nia. n. Stork. (Latin *Ciconia*, a genus.) Also *keko-leka*.

kī.konī.konī. Redup. of *kīkonī*.

kiko nī.nau. n. Question mark, interrogation point.

kī.ko'o. nvt. Span; extent; a measure from the end of the thumb to the end of the index finger; chord of an arc; a bent bow; a long surfboard, 3.7 to 5.5 m long; to stretch, reach or stick out; extend, as the hands, or as a bird its wings; to move; to shoot, as from a bow; to step in order to reach; to pay out money, disburse, draw money from the bank. Cf. *pana 'iole. Palapala kīko'o, pepa kīko'o*, check or draft. *Lele kīko'o*, to take a flying leap with one foot first. *Pila kīko'o*, check, draft; bill. *'Ehā kīko'o i koe o kō iala maika'i iāia nei* (Laie 363), that one's beauty is four times greater than this one's. (PCP *tiitoko*.)

kī.ko'o.ko'o. Redup. of *kīko'o*.

kī.ko'o.lā. vi. **1.** Sarcastic, rude, tart, impertinent, insolent. **2.** Haphazard, miscellaneous; here, there, and everywhere; topsy-turvy; carelessly performed, entangled; of awkward shape, as a package. See *waiwai kīko'olā*.

kī.ko'o pā.nā'i. n. Bill of exchange. *Lit.*, exchange disbursement.

kī.ko'o pana 'iole. See *pana 'iole*. (FS 55.)

kī.ko'o pana.kō. n. Bank check.

kiko pū.'iwa. n. Exclamation mark.

kī.ko'u. vt. To cultivate with a hoe or digging stick; to rap or strike with a club; to tap.

kiko.wāona. n. Center of a circle; headquarters; Central, telephone operator; bull's eye. See ex., *'ōhea*.

kī.kū. vi. To lean back firmly. *Ni'ihau i ke kīkū* (saying), Ni'ihau leans firmly back [the people of Ni'ihau are independent].

kila. **1.** nvs. High place; strong, stout, bold. *Rare*. Cf. *kilakila*. **2.** Also *silā*. nvt. Seal, deed, patent, brand; sealed; to fix a seal. See *palapala kila nui. Eng. Ua kila 'ia anei kāu palapala?* Was your document sealed? *Kēlā pū'ā kao . . . i hō'ailona 'ia me ko'u kila*, that flock of goats . . . marked with my brand. **3.** n. Steel, knife blade, chisel. *Eng. Pu'uwai hao kila*, a heart of steel [of courage]. **4.** nvt. Pen; to write with a pen. Probably *Eng. quill. Rare*. **5.** n. Earmark, as on cattle. **6.** (*Cap.*) Also *Silā*. n. Silas. *Eng.* **7.** Also *gila*. n. Gill, a small liquid measure. *Eng.*

kī.lā.'au. n. Wooden key or latch, as in a gate.

kī.laha. vs. Broad, wide, ample, enlarged. Cf. *laha*.

kila.kila. vs. Majestic, tall, strong, imposing; having
