

kohea. nvi. Warm, clear, serene weather; to be such.
kohe 'ako. n. Venereal disease of women. *Lit.*, itching vagina.
kō.he'e. vi. To train or practice, as for foot races. (Malo 219.)
kō.heheo. Var. of *kōheoheo*.
kohe.kohe. n. 1. All species of a genus of sedges (*Eleocharis*), some introduced, some native. (Neal 87.) Also *pīpī wai*. See 'aoa 4. 2. Tonsillitis (used with *pu'u*). 3. Same as 'ōkohekohe 2, barnacle.
kohe.kohea. Redup. of *kohea*.
kohe.kohe papa. n. 1. A variety of *kohekohe* plant. 2. Bilateral tonsillitis.
kohe.lelewa. Same as *kohelewalewa*.
kohe.lēmu. vs. Dull, inattentive, inactive.
kohe.lēmu. n. 1. Division between the vagina and anus. 2. Sodomy. *Lit.*, anus vagina.
kohe.lēwa.lēwa. n. A white *loli* that lives in the sand (perhaps *Holothuria arenicola*). *Lit.*, hanging vagina.
kohe lua. vs. Double-barbed, of a fishhook.
kohe lua pa'a. Same as *kohe lua*.
kohe.nalo. nvt. Corrugated stone used for smoothing wood or stone; to file or rasp with this stone.
kō.heo. 1. vt. To show off, parade, strut. **ho'o.kōheo**. Caus/sim. 2. Var. of *pōheo*, head of penis. 3. Same as *kōheoheo* 3.
kō.heo.heo. 1. vi. To fall, as through the air; to tumble. 'Opū nui kewekewe, pā i ka lani, kōheoheo! (children's song ridiculing a fat stomach), big rounded belly, touch the sky and tumble down. *Lele kōheoheo i ka pali o Ka-pa'a-heo*, tumbling from the cliff of Ka-pa'a-heo [a "goner," play on *heo*, gone]. 2. nvs. Poisonous. *He 'apu 'auhuhu kōheoheo*, a poisonous concoction of 'auhuhu; *fig.*, a poisonous-natured person. 3. n. Coat-tail. 4. n. Stick or buoy that floats a fishhook. 5. Redup. of *kōheo*. 6. n. Nose flute (*hano* is more common).
kohe.popo. n. An ancient sickness characterized by ill-smelling vaginal discharge. *Lit.*, rotten vagina.
kōhi. 1. nvt. To gather, as fruit; to break off neatly, as taro corm from the stalk with a stick or knife; to split, as breadfruit; to dig (For. 4:510); splitter, as stick, stone, knife. *Nā wāhine kōhi noni* (FS 217), the *noni*-gathering women [an insult to Pele, perhaps likening her disposition to sour *noni* fruit]. (PPN *tofi*.) 2. nvs. Fat, rich, as food; fatness. *Nā kōhi kelekele o Ka-pu'u-kolu*, the rich foods of Ka-pu'u-kolu [Kaua'i, famous for abundance]. 3. vt. To fill or heal, of a wound. *Ke kōhi maila ka 'i'o*, the flesh is beginning to heal. 4. nvt. To hold back, check, restrain; to strain, especially as in childbirth, to travail; to hold or hold back by pressing a person's arm, as in withholding consent, or as in urging someone not to be generous; labor pains, travail. *Fig.*, agony, fear. Cf. *haukōhi*, *kāohi*. **ho'o.kōhi**. Caus/sim. Also *ha'akōhi*. 5. vs. Prolonged, as a sound; long. *He kōhi ka leo*, the sound is long.
kō.hia. Pas/imp. of *kōhi*. *Kōhia mai mākou e ka makani Mōa'e* (chant), we were held back by the Mōa'e wind. *Kōhia aku ka 'Ilio*, hold back the dog.
kōhi 'ai. To separate taro corm from stalk; to pick taro.
kōhi.kōhi. Same as *kōkōhi*; to cull, separate, grade, as fish or sweet potatoes.
kōhi.kū. Same as *kōkōhikū*, to lay waste.
kōhi.kōhi-kū-pala.lā. n. Children's guessing game, with an object hidden in the earth or sand.
kō.hina. n. Part of taro where the corm is cut away from the top; splitting of a breadfruit for cooking.
koho. 1. nvt. Guess, election, choice, selection, interpretation; to choose, select, bid, guess, estimate, anticipate, decide on, pick, nominate, vote, elect, draw lots. *Lā koho*, election day. *Koho lā'au*, to draw straws. *Po'e i koho 'ia*, chosen representatives. *Mea koho*, bidder. 'O wai kāu moho i koho ai? Which candidate did you vote for? *Po'e koho pāloka*, voters. *I ke koho 'ana o nā 'ao'ao*, at option of parties. **ho'o.koho**. To choose, elect, appoint. (Probably PPN *tofo*.) 2. n. Tip of a paddle blade.

koho honua. vt. To choose at random, without thought or care, arbitrarily; to vote without forethought, or for the sake of voting.
kō.hoko. n. An infection, probably luetic.
koho.koho. Redup. of *koho* 1.
-koho.kola. **ho'o.koho.kola**. Same as *hō'aikola*. Rare.
kohola. 1. n. Reef flats, bare reef. *Kai kohola*, lagoon. (PPN *tofo*.) 2. The first law a chief promulgates, a strict law. (And.)
koho.lā. n. Humpbacked whale. (PNP *tafo'a*, PEP *tafo'a*, PCP *tofo'aa*.)
Koho.lā Lele. n. Name of a wind blowing from east to west, associated with Hāmākua, Hawai'i, and Hāna, Maui. Also *Kiu* and *Koholā Pehu* (also of Kī-pahulu, Maui, Nak. 68). *Lit.*, leaping whale.
koho.lā.pēhu. n. A scandent shrub, native to Kaua'i, in the composite family (*Dubautis latifolia*), with long branches, opposite, elliptical, pointed leaves, and small flower heads in large panicles.
Koho.lā Pēhu. See *Koholā Lele*.
koho.lua. n. 1. Lance for boils, sores, as of fishbone or a sharp stick; abortion stick; this term, like that referring to other sharp things (shark, sea urchin, eel) is applied to chiefs as indicative of the sharp defense of the chief against contact with his taboo person, or infringement of his taboos. *He koholua 'oi ke ali'i*, a sharp-pointed piercing instrument is the chief. 2. A long shellfish (*Terebra* spp.)
koho mua. n. First choice, primary election, first guess; hypothesis. *Uku koho mua*, upset price, in public bidding.
kō honua 'ula. Same as *honua'ula*, a sugar cane.
koho pā.loka. nv. To cast a ballot, vote; voting, election, suffrage.
koho polo.lēi. nvt. Right choice; to choose rightly; to vote a straight ticket.
koho wae moho. n. Primary election. *Lit.*, candidate-selection election.
kohu. 1. nvs. Resemblance, appearance, likeness, match; suitable, agreeable, appropriate, matching, in good taste, attractive, becoming, pleasing, fit, like, resembling, alike, similar. See *kohu ali'i*, *kohu like*, *kohu pono*. 'A'ohe kohu iki, most inappropriate, unsuitable, in very bad taste, absurd. *Kohu kēnā pāpale iā'oe*, that hat is becoming to you. *He kohu haole nō ke namu mai*, talks just like a white person. 'O kēlā kanaka, he kohu Pukiki'i 'oe ke nānā aku, he looks just like a Portuguese. *Hiki i ke kameleona ke 'o'olopū i kona kohu 'ana, i hinahina, i 'ōma'oma'o, i 'ele'ele*, the chameleon can change his appearance to gray, green, black. *Ua kohu au me ia lā, me ka liko lehua o uka*, I'm a good match for her, for the *lehua* bud of the upland [a young girl]. **ho'o.kohu**. To assume a likeness to; to presume to; to make advances, perhaps hypocritically; to take a fancy to; to have a crush on; presumption, pretense. *Mea ho'okohu*, thing that matches, accessories. *Nānā aku 'oe i ka ho'okohu o mea iā Pole*, see how so-and-so is infatuated with Pole. 'A'ole ho'i i ka ho'okohu o ka make'e waiwai (1 Tes. 2.5), nor a pretense of covetousness. *Ho'okohu ka ua i uka*, how fit and pleasing is the rain of the uplands. 2. nvs. Sap, stain, blot; stained, discolored. *Mālama o kohu kō lōle*, be careful or you'll stain your dress. *Wai i kohu i nā hua waina* (Nah. 6.3), liquor of grapes; *lit.*, liquid that is juice in grapes. *Kohu 'nika*, ink blot. 3. See *limu kohu*.
-kohu. **ho'o.kohu**. To appoint, commission, authorize. *Ho'okohu 'ia 'o Keoni i kumu kula*, John was appointed school teacher. *Palapala ho'okohu*, certificate of appointment.
kohu ali'i. vs. Of chiefly bearing, stately, noble.
kohu.kohu. 1. Redup. of *kohu* 1. *Kohukohu 'oe i ke kau lio*, attractive you are on horseback. **ho'o.kohu.kohu**. Redup. of *ho'okohu*; to pretend, impersonate, disguise, pose; affectation. *Ho'okohukohu kālana māka'iki'u*, impersonation of the office of detective. *He ho'okohukohu ho'ohanohano* (Kep. 105), a person
