

kuawa ke'o.ke'o. n. A form of guava with white pulp (*Psidium guajava*), but otherwise like *kuawa lemi*. (Neal 632-3.)

kuawa lemi. n. Lemon guava (*Psidium guajava*), a form of guava with sour, pink pulp. *Lit.*, lemon guava. (Neal 632.)

kuawa momona. n. A form of guava (*Psidium guajava*) with sweet, pink pulp, thicker skin, and larger seeds than *kuawa lemi*. *Lit.*, sweet guava. (Neal 632.)

kua-wā.wāe-nohu. n. A shrub in the carnation family (*Schiedea lychnoides*), endemic to Kaua'i; leaves broad-ovate, 4 to 5 cm long, flowers many and small; said to be named for a place on Kaua'i.

kua.wēhi. n. 1. Dark caterpillar resembling the *poko*, cutworm, about 5 cm or less in length; it feeds on grass and comes in great numbers. 2. Overexposure to the sun; excessive ultraviolet rays.

kua.wēli. vs. Dark in color. (Kam. 64:112.)

kua.wili. nvt. Long repetitious prayer said at *luakini* dedication ceremonies, hence repetitiousness in general; to repeat, wander, digress, perhaps senselessly. *Ā i ka pule 'ana, mai kuawili wale aku 'oukou i ka 'ōlelo* (Mat. 6.7), but when ye pray, use not vain repetitions.

kuē 1. interj. Call to attract 'ua'u, petrel birds, believed in imitation of their sound. 2. n. Fishhook with point of hook curved inward almost to the shaft, used for large fish.

ku'ē 1. vi. To push with the elbows, to elbow; to move back and forth, as a piston or as the action of the tide. Cf. *ha'aku'e*. (PEP *tuke*.) 2. vs. Deformed, malformed.

kū.ē. nvt. To oppose, resist, protest; opposite, versus, adverse, contrary, antagonistic, unwilling; objection. *Lit.*, stand different. *He mana'o kū'ē*, an opposite meaning. *Kū'ē kānāwai*, unlawful, contrary to law, illegal, against the law. *Kū'ē aupuni*, opposed or disloyal to the government, rebel. *Hana kū'ē*, violation, opposition. *Mea kū'ē*, adversary, opponent. *Kū'ē i ka palapala kauoha*, to contest a will. *Kū'ē i kō ha'i mana'o*, to oppose others' views; intolerant. *Nā kāhuna kū'ē i ka Pope*, ministers opposed to the Pope, Protestant ministers. *Kū'ē kumukānāwai*, unconstitutional. **ho'o.kū.ē.** To cause opposition, to stir up resistance; to oppose, clash.

kuēa 1. n. Square. *Eng. Kamaki Kuea*, Thomas Square. *Kapua'i kuea*, square foot. 2. vt. To swear. *Eng. 'ōlelo kuea*, oath. 3. n. Squad (military). *Eng.*

Kū.ēa. n. Star name (no data). (Kuhelani.)

kū.ē.ē. 1. Redup. of *kū'ē*; disagreement, dissension, opposition, quarrel, bickering, animosity; to quarrel, bicker, disagree. **ho'o.kū.ē.ē.** To stir up opposition or disagreement. 2. n. Double canoe with one canoe longer than the other. (Malo 131.)

kuēhu, kuwēhu. vt. To shake, stir up, as dust; to knock a club from a foe's hands; to toss up, as spray; to brandish, wave; to clear of weeds; to drive off, especially evil spirits (tapa or ti leaves were torn into strips, blessed, and passed over a patient in order to exorcise spirits). Cf. *ehu*, spray. See *Kuehu Lepo*. 'O ka pali o Kīkī-ōpua i Ho'omalele, e lele ana nā momoku kuehu pali (For. 6:472), at the cliffs of Kīkī-ōpua at Ho'omalele, firebrands leap spraying over cliffs.

kū.ēhu.ēhu. Redup. of *kuehu*.

Kuehu Kai. n. Name of a wind of Milo-li'i, Kaua'i. (For. 5:95.)

kuehu kapa. v. To shake a tapa in a way that seems innocent but that will bring a curse upon the person to whom the motion is directed. (Kam. 64:141.)

Kuehu Lepo. n. Name of a wind of Nā-ā-lehu, Ka'ū (For. 5:93) and O'ahu (Nak. 56). *Lit.*, dust scatterer. 'O Ka'ū i ka makani, ka makani Kuehu Lepo (song), Ka'ū in the wind, the dust-raising wind.

kuēka. n. 1. Sweater. *Eng.* 2. (Cap.) Quaker. *Eng.*

kuēka'a. vt. To ransack, search. *Pau ka ukana i ke kueka'a 'ia*, the luggage was all ransacked.

Kuē.kena, Suedena. nvs. Sweden; Swede; Swedish. *Eng.*

kuē.kuē. nvt. Sound of tapping, tap, as of a mallet on a tapa anvil; to tap-tap. *Kani kuekue a ka i'e kuku*, thumping of the tapa mallet.

ku'ē.ku'ē. n. Elbow, wristbone, joint, knuckle. Cf. *ku'eku'e lima*, *ku'eku'e wāwae*. **ho'o.ku'ē.ku'ē.** To elbow, push with the elbows. (PEP *tuketuke*.)

kū.ē.kū.ē. Same as *kū'ē'ē*.

kuē.kuēhu. Redup. of *kuehu*.

ku'ē.ku'ē lima. n. Elbow.

ku'ē.ku'ē.maka. n. Eyebrow. **ho'o.ku'ē.ku'ē.maka.** To frown. *Ho'oku'eku'emaka nui*, to frown severely, scowl.

ku'ē.ku'ēna. vi. To push aside; to move back and forth, as a fan belt.

kuē.kuēne. Redup. of *kuene*. **ho'o.kuē.kuēne.** Caus/sim. *Rare*.

kuē.kuēni. vi, vt. To shake, tremble, vibrate, swing back and forth, as a waving *kāhili*, feather emblem.

kuē.kuē'o. vi. Able to move only slightly, as one hurt in an accident or as one near death.

ku'ē.ku'ē pipi. n. Beef joint or knuckle; soupbone.

ku'ē.ku'ē wā.wāe. n. Ankle joint, heel.

kū.ēle.kā. vi. Shiftless; to vagabond. *Rare*.

ku'ē lima. n. Elbow.

kuēlo, kuwēlo. n. Hard, cooked taro. Also *kūpu'u*.

ku'ē.maka. n. Eyebrow. See ex., *nunu 2*, and saying, 'ea'ea. **ho'o.ku'ē.maka.** To frown, scowl. (PCP *tukemata*.)

ku'ē.maka pali. n. Brow of a cliff.

kuē manu. v. To attract 'ua'u, petrel birds, to a net by imitating their call, *kue, kue, kue!*

kuēmi. vi. To step back; to walk backward, as from the presence of a chief; to retreat; to shrink back, recoil, flinch, withdraw.

kū.ēna. vs. Glowing, burning.

kuēne. nvt. Waiter, steward, treasurer; to wait on table; to supervise, put in order, arrange; to lay out, as measurements for a building. *Kuene po'o*, head waiter. *Kuene hale*, knowledge of house building, one skilled in house building; house waiter. *E kuene pono iho ai no kona kūlana* (GP 66), to keep up his reputation. *E kuene pono iho ana lā, i pa'a pono ke kaula waha* (chant for Queen Emma), all was fitted perfectly, so that the reins could be firmly held. **ho'o.kuēne.** Caus/sim.; all meanings. (Perhaps PCP *tuen(e,i)*: cf. Marquesan *tueni*, servant.)

kuēne kāne. n. Waiter.

kuēne wahine. n. Waitress, stewardess.

kuēne.nu'u. vs. Completely stuffed, packed, as after overeating. *E 'ai aku i ka 'ulu a kuenuenu'u ka mā'ona*, eat breadfruit until stuffed full, satiated.

kuēni. Same as *kuekueni*.

kuē'o. nvi. Insecure, unsteady, unskilled. *Kū wale ana i ka hoka, kue'o wale ana i ka mauna* (For. 6:376), in a state of being thwarted, insecure on the mountain. *Nā loea ame nā kue'o*, the skilled and the unskilled.

kū.ē'o.ē'o. Redup. of *kue'o*.

kuēwa. nvi. Vagabond, exile, wanderer; wandering, friendless, homeless, unstable. *E lilo ho'i 'oe i kanaka 'ae'a a me ke kuēwa wale maluna o ka honua* (Kin. 4.12), a fugitive and vagabond shalt thou be in the earth. **ho'o.kuēwa.** Caus/sim.

kū.ēwa. vs. Askew, placed obliquely.

kuha. nvi. Saliva, spittle, sputum, expectoration; to spit, expectorate. (Ioane 9.6.) *Pakt ke kuha*, the saliva spat- ters [said of one who raves and rants, or spits constantly]. (PCP *tufa*.)

kū.ha'a.liki. vt. To brag, boast.

kuha.ēka. vs. Shabby, dirty.

kuhā.iki. vs. Narrow; in straitened circumstances.

kū.haka. vs. Of high position, as one possessed by the gods. *Lit.*, stand perch. *Kūlana kūhaka*, manner of one in high position.

kū.hā.kakai. vs. Swollen, fat. *Rare*.

kuha.kuha. Redup. of *kuha*. (PCP *tufatufa*.)

kū.hala.hala. vt. To find fault with, criticize; dissatisfied. Also *ho'ohalahala*.
