

- laiki, raisi.** n. Rice (*Oryza sativa*). (Neal 69–71.) Eng.
- lai.kī.** n. Litchi. Eng.
- lā.iki.** vs. Tight, as a dress; painfully stuffed, as the stomach after overeating; narrow, as a gate opening (contraction of *lā'ā*, wide, and *iki*, small). *Lima lā'iki*, long, narrow sleeve.
- laiki loloa.** n. Long rice.
- lai.kini.** n. License. Eng. *Wahine laikini*, licensed prostitute.
- lai.kini hahai holo.holona.** n. Hunting license.
- lai.kini ka'a.** n. Auto or vehicle license.
- lai.kini kalaiwa ka'a.** n. Driver's license.
- lai.kini kīpū.** n. Firearms license.
- lā'i.kū.** nvs. 1. Great calm, quiet, peace, serenity; becalmed. 2. (Cap.) Name of a wind associated with Hālawā, Moloka'i. (For. 5:103.)
- laila.** loc. n. There, then (usually pronounced *leila* or *lila*; Gram. 2.7, 8.6). *Laila* follows particles with varying meanings: *Ā laila*, then. *I laila*, there, at that place. *Mai laila mai ā hiki i keia mau makahiki*, from then until the present years. *Kō laila*, of that place, local. *He 'olu'olu kō laila po'e*, the people of that locality are kind. *Malaila*, there. *Mai laila*, from there, thence. *No laila*, therefore, for that reason, hence, consequently; belonging to that place. *O laila*, of that place. *'A'ohe a'u mea makemake o laila*, there is nothing I want there. (PEP *l(a,e)ila*.)
- lā'i.lā'i.** 1. Redup. of *lā'i*; light-hearted. **ho'o.lā'i.lā'i.** Caus/sim. 2. n. A variety of sweet potato.
- lai.mana.** n. Layman. Eng. Rare.
- laina.** n. 1. Hives, urticaria. 2. Line, row, verse. Eng. 3. Cane trash (Eng. rind), bagasse.
- laina kaula waha.** n. Reins, lines. *Lit.*, bridle (rope mouth) lines.
- laina.kini.** Same as *'ainakini*, navy blue cloth.
- laina moku.ahi.** n. Steamship line.
- lā'i-o-kona.** n. 1. A variety of sweet potato. *Lit.*, calm of Kona. 2. Design on a tapa beater.
- lai.pala.** Same as *laipila*, libel.
- lā.ī.pala.** n. A bright-yellow reef fish (*Zebrasoma flavescens*). *Lit.*, yellow ti leaf. Also *lau'īpala*, *laukīpala*.
- lai.pela, raifela.** n. Rifle. Eng.
- lai.pila.** nvt. Libel; to libel. Eng.
- lā'i.pū.** vs. To be peaceful.
- laka.** 1. vs, vt. Tame, domesticated, gentle, docile; attracted to, fond of; to tame, domesticate, attract. See ex., *'ena 2. Nui ka laka o kēia keiki i ke kupuna*, this child is so fond of the grandparent. *Ē Laka ē . . . e laka i ka leo, e laka i ka loa'a, e laka i ka waiwai* (UL 34), O Laka, attract the voice, attract profit, attract wealth. *Mai 'ena i ke kanaka i laka aku*, don't shy away from a person attracted [to you]. **ho'o.laka.** To tame, domesticate; to treat with kindness, as a child or animal, so as to familiarize with one. (PPN *lata*.) 2. nvt. Lock, padlock; to lock. Eng. 3. n. Lark. Eng.
- lā.kā.** n. Lascar. Eng.
- laka.heke.** n. Loghead. Eng.
- laka.laka.** Redup. of *laka* 1. **ho'o.laka.laka.** Redup. of *ho'olaka*. (PPN *latalata*.)
- lā.kana.** n. 1. Lantana (*Lantana camara*), a thorny tropical American bush with variegated flower heads, yellow, orange, red, white, and pink. Eng. Also *lanakana* (*Ni'ihau*), *mikinolia hihui*, *mikinolia hohono*, *mikinolia kukū*. (Neal 722–4.) 2. (Cap.) Also **Ladana**. London. Eng. See song, *luala'i*.
- Lā Kā.paki.** n. Sabbath Day.
- lā kau.** n. Setting sun. See *lā hiki*.
- Lā Kau Pua.** n. Decoration Day. *Lit.*, day to place flowers.
- lā.keā.** vs. Fair, white, of complexion. Rare.
- lā kea.** n. White fin.
- lā.ke'e.** Var. of *lāpe'e*.
- lakēke.** n. Jacket, blouse. Eng.
- lā.kewe.** Same as *lāke'e*, bending.
- laki.** nvs. Luck, lucky. See ex., *keha*. Eng. **ho'o.laki.** To bring luck; lucky.
- lā.kī.** 1. nvs. Ti leaf (short for *lau kī*). 2. vs. Stunted, as of plants that have matured. *Lākī mai kō lāua ulu 'ana* (Kep. 93), their growth was stunted [of plants].
- lakika, radika.** n. Radix. Eng.
- lā.kike, latike.** n. Lattice. Eng.
- lā.kū, latitu.** n. Latitude. Eng.
- Lā.kina, Latina.** n. Latin. *Inoa Lākina*, Latin or scientific name.
- lakio, ratio.** n. Ratio. Eng.
- lakio like.** n. Proportion, equal ratio.
- lakio like 'ano hui.** n. Compound proportion.
- lakio like huli hope.** n. Indirect-inverse or reciprocal proportion.
- lakio like kau.kahi.** n. Simple proportion or ratio.
- lakio like kū.pono.** n. Direct proportion, equal ratio.
- lako.** nvs. Supply, provisions, gear, fixtures, plenty; wealth; well-supplied, well-furnished, well-equipped; rich, prosperous. **ho'o.lako.** To supply, equip, provide, furnish, enrich. (PCP *lato*.)
- lā.kō.** n. Sugar-cane leaf (same as *lā'ō*, contraction of *lau kō*).
- lako hale.** n. Furniture and fixtures for a house. Same as *pono hale*.
- lako kā.kau.** n. Stationery supplies.
- lako kaua.** n. War supplies, ammunition, munitions, armament. **ho'o.lako kaua.** To supply arms, arm, fortify.
- lako ke'ena.** n. Office supplies.
- lako kula.** n. 1. School supplies. 2. Also **lako gula.** Jewelry, especially gold.
- lako.lako.** Rare redup. of *lako*. **ho'o.lako.lako.** Redup. of *ho'olako*.
- lako lawai'a.** n. Fishing tackle.
- lā.kou.** pronoun. They, them (more than two). (Gram. 8.2.) See *ē lākou ala* and *ē lākou nei* for use of *lākou* as a third person plural vocative. *Lākou iho*, they themselves. *Kā lākou, kō lākou*, their (*a-* and *o-*forms). (PNP *kilaatou*, PCP *laatou*.)
- lakua.** To talk incongruously, mixing proper and improper talk. (And.)
- lā.kulā.ia.** n. Day of celebration in honor of a chief.
- lakuna, rakuna.** n. Raccoon. Eng.
- lala.** 1. nvs. Diagonal, slanting, oblique; diagonal surfing or surf. *Pā lala*, to blow at an angle, of the wind. *He'e ana i ka lala lā, ho'i ana i ka muku* (song for Ka-lā-kaua), surf out diagonally, come back on the crest. (Thrum's Annual, 1896, page 109, says that the *lala* is the seaward side of a wave building up to break; a third interpretation is that *lala* is a wave to the right, and *muku* a wave to the left.) **ho'o.lala.** To turn aside. (PCP *lala*.) 2. vi. To warm, as over a fire, to warm oneself by a fire; to bask in the sun; to cook over a fire. Cf. *'ōlala 2.* (PPN *lala, rara*.) 3. vs. Bright, shiny. (PPN *lala*.) 4. vs. Thin. Also *'ōlala*. 5. n. Cap visor. 6. n. A small bait fish (no data). 7. vt. To straighten. 8. n. A style of diagonal quilting. 9. The four corners of a house. (And.)
- lā.lā.** 1. nvi. Branch, limb, bough, coconut frond; timber, as of outrigger boom or float; wing of an army; to branch out, form branches, diverge. *Lālā 'u'uku*, small branch, twig. *Lālā 'ole*, without branches; *fig.*, childless. *Lālā ola*, person with offspring. **ho'o.lā.lā.** To cause to branch out, as by topping; to branch out. to lay out land areas; to mark with lines; to plan, make plans or projects (see ex., *'ōhio*). (PPN *ra'ara'a*.) 2. n. Member, as of a society. 3. n. Term in fractions. 4. n. Slip, as of hibiscus. Also *lālā ho'oulu*. 5. n. Sweet potato produced on a branch vine. 6. n. Barb or hook, as of bone or coconut shell, on a mother-of-pearl lure; bone point of a composite hook. 7. n. Fins. See *lā 4*.
- lā.lā'au.** vs. Rotten, as of eggs; disturbed, addled. Rare.
- lā.laha.** vs. Broad. *Lit.*, broad surface.
- lala.hai.** Same as *lahalahai*.
- lā.laha.laha.** vs. To rise and swell, of surf before it breaks; broad, as a surface.
- lalahela.** Lazy, sinful. (And.)
- lā.lahi.** vs. Thin, delicate. *Lit.*, thin surface.
- lala.hiwa.** vs. Dark, as of a cloud.
