

- lole.hau.** vs. Limping, lame. *Rare.*
- lole.holoi.** n. Laundry; soiled clothes ready to be washed, washing.
- lole.komo.** n. Clothes, garments. *Lit.*, clothes to put on.
- lole.lau.** n. Thatching and trimming, of a house. *Lit.*, handle leaves.
- lole.lau.oho.** n. Sackcloth of hair. (Hoik. 6.12.)
- lole.lapo.** n. Soiled clothing, laundry.
- lole.lole.** Redup. of *lole* 2. *Mai ki'i 'oe e lolole i ku'u ukana*, don't you go and go through my things. 'Ōlelo *lolole*, twisted, not straight-forward, roundabout speech. (PCP *lolole*.)
- lole.lua.** nvs. Changeable, fickle, unstable, inconstant, inconsistent, variable; turncoat.
- lole.moe.pō.** n. Nightgown. *Lit.*, night-sleeping clothes.
- lolena.** 1. Nominalizing form of *lole* 2. *Palai lolena*, fern turned over. 2. vs. Limp, flexible, as cloth; inefficient, unproductive, idle, sterile, barren, faded. *He u'i lolena kū i ki'ona* (saying), a stupid beauty fit for the dung hill. 'A'ohē *lolena i ka wai 'ōpae* (saying), no slackers in water full of shrimps [there must be no slackers when work is to be done].
- lole.pai.kau.** n. Marching garments, regalia, full regalia.
- lole.papa.mū.** n. Checkered dress, especially gingham.
- lole.pia.** n. Laundry washed, starched, and dried but not ironed. *Lit.*, starch clothes.
- lole.wai.** n. Laundry washed and dried but not starched or ironed. *Lit.*, water clothes.
- lole.wā.wae.** n. Trousers, pants, panties, slacks. *Lit.*, leg clothes.
- lole.wā.wae 'eke.ke'i.** n. Shorts.
- lole.wā.wae 'epane.** n. Overalls, coveralls. *Lit.*, apron trousers.
- lole.wā.wae loloa.** n. Long trousers.
- lole.wā.wae moe.pō.** n. Pajamas. *Lit.*, trousers for night sleeping.
- lole.wā.wae.pō.kole.** n. Short trousers, shorts.
- lole.wā.wae.pū.ha'u.ha'u.** n. Bloomers. *Lit.*, puffed-up trousers.
- loli.** 1. vt. To change, alter, influence, turn, turn over. *Loli wale*, to change for apparently no reason or whimsically; variable. *Loli 'ana*, change, conversion, variation, evolution. *Loli a'e*, to vary, change. **ho'o.loli.** To change, convert, exchange, alter, transform, take a new form, amend; amendment, change. *Ho'ololi i ka lole*, change clothes. *Ho'ololi 'ōlelo*, amend, decline, conjugate. *Ho'ololi i ka mana'o*, to change the mind. *Ho'ololi mai i ka noi*, to amend a motion. *Ho'ololi kālā*, currency exchange. 2. n. Sea slug, sea cucumber, beche-de-mer, trepang (*Holothuria* spp.); for some people an 'aumakua. See *kūkaeloli* and saying, 'loli. (PPN *loli*.) 3. vs. Spotted, speckled, daubed; to color in spots, as tapa. Cf. 'loli 2.
- lolia.** Pas/imp. of *loli* 1. **ho'o.lolia.** Caus/sim.
- loli 'ano.** n. Change of nature, as of words and their etymology.
- lōli'i.** v. Relaxed, at ease, without worry, carefree. *Moe lōli'i*, to lie at ease. *Ua noho 'o Maleka ā lōli'i* (song), America is well prepared.
- loli ka'ē.** n. A variety of *loli*, sea slug.
- loli kohola.** n. A variety of *loli* (*Holothuria*), black and cylindrical. *Lit.*, reef *loli*.
- loli koko.** n. A variety of *loli*, perhaps *Chirodota rigida*. *Lit.*, blood *loli*.
- loli.loli.** 1. Redup. of *loli* 1; changing, turning, changeable. **ho'o.loli.loli.** Caus/sim. See ex., *ka'ina*. 2. vs. Soggy, gummy, tough and watery, as overripe taro.
- loli.lua.** Same as *lololeua*.
- loli lū'au.** n. A variety of *loli* (*Holothuria*). *Lit.*, taro-tops *loli*.
- loli mā.koko.** n. A variety of *loli*, perhaps *Chirodota rigida*. *Lit.*, blood-red *loli*.
- lolina.** n. A change, alteration.
- lolio.** vs. Skinny, thin. Cf. *lio*, taut.
- loli pua.** n. A species of edible *loli* (*Holothuria*). *Lit.*, flower *loli*.
- lolo.** 1. n. Brains, bone marrow. *Kau ka lā i ka lolo*, the sun rests on the brains [it is noon; usually now without other connotation, but formerly believed a time with great *mana* as a man's *aka* (shadow, image) was no longer visible and was thought to have entered his sacred head—Nānā 123–4]. *Lolo 'eleu*, active mind or intelligence. (PPN *lolo*, oily; PEP brains; cf. *lololo* 2.) 2. nvs. Religious ceremony at which the brain of the sacrificed animal was eaten (such ceremonies occurred at a canoe launching, start of journey, completion of instruction); to have completed the *lolo* ceremony, hence expert, skilled. *He lolo 'au moana*, seafaring expert. *A'o ihola 'o Hale-mano i ka hula . . . pau ke a'o 'ana, lolo ihola i ka pua'a* (FS 275), Hale-mano learned the hula . . . after learning, a pig was offered ceremonially. 3. n. Pithy, white sponge in a sprouting coconut. Also *iho*. 4. n. Long slender pole placed above the second ridgepole of a house, functioning as a batten for the attachment of additional layers of thatch. Also *lolo 'iole*. 5. n. First brew made from ti root. 6. Short for *hīnālea 'akilolo*, a fish. (PCP *lolo*.) 7. Same as *holowa'a*, sheath covering coconut flowers. 8. interj. Serves you right! I told you so!
- lō.lō.** vs. Paralyzed, numb, feeble-minded, crazy. *Lōlō moe hālau*, stupid one who sleeps in a workshop [a lazybones]. See *paka lōlō*. **ho'o.lō.lō.** To pretend paralysis, stupidity; to pretend to be asleep.
- loloa.** 1. Redup. of *loa* 1. *Lima loloa*, long sleeve. **ho'o.loloa.** To lengthen. (PPN *loloa*.) 2. n. A seaweed (KL line 95), probably the same as *limu loloa*.
- lolo'a.** vs. Bleached, as a shell in the sea.
- Loloa-mai.au.** n. Same as *Ka-loloa-mai.au*.
- lolo.a'u.** n. Flying gurnard, a fish (*Dactyloptena orientalis*). Also *pinao*.
- loloha.** Redup. of *loha*, to droop.
- lolohe.** 1. Redup. of *lohe*; to listen carefully, attentively, with good hearing. *He pepeiao lolohe*, an ear with good hearing. **ho'o.lolohe.** To listen carefully; to strain the ear to hear. *He ali'i 'o ka lani, he mo'opuna na Lono, he hiapo na ke kini, ho'ololohe ua* (chant), the heavenly one is a chief, a descendant of Lono, the first-born of a multitude [of long lineage], a listener to the rain [unafraid of rain because of high rank]. 2. vs. Stubborn; hard to move, as a rock. *Rare.* Cf. *ho'okololohe*. **ho'o.lolohe.** Caus/sim.
- lolohi.** Redup. of *lohi* 1; slowpoke. *Lolohi ke a'o 'ana*, slow in learning. **ho'o.lolohi.** Similar to *ho'olohi*. (For. 5:553.)
- lolo.hili.** Var. of *loloihili*.
- lolo.hua.** Same as *mīkololohua*.
- lolo.huā, lolo.huwā.** nvs. One who is jealous and constantly stirring up trouble; jealous.
- lolo.hua.mea.** 1. Same as *lolohua*. 2. n. Variegated colors, as of the distant sea. See ex., *lipo* 1.
- lolo.iā.hili.** vs. To wander, as one lost; to stray, dilly-dally; to digress and wander in speech; roundabout. **ho'o.lolo.iā.hili.** Same as above. *Me ka ho'ololoihili 'ole aku*, without further digression.
- lōlō.iēle.** Redup. of *lōiele*; dull. **ho'o.lōlō.iēle.** Caus/sim. *Ho'ololōiele kāna hana 'ana*, he works so slowly.
- lolo 'iole.** Same as *lolo* 4.
- lolo iwi.** n. Bone marrow.
- lolo.ka'a.** nvs. Dizziness, with spinning head; dizzy. Cf. *niu loloka'a, pōniuniu*. See ex., *noiele*.
- lolo.kia.** n. Coconut stem.
- loloku.** Same as *lokuloku*. 'O lili'u 'o loloku 'o waliania i ke ki'i'ōnohi (song), smarting, tearful, burning are the eyeballs.
- lolo.kū.** n. 1. Midday. *Ke lolokū aku nei*, it is noon. Cf. *kau ka lā i ka lolo*, under *lolo* 1. 2. Muscle on back of the head, probably the occipito-frontalis muscle; the nervous system. Also *molokū*.
- lolo.kukui.** nvt. To be raped, sexually molested or ravished; such a victim. *Ua lapa'au 'ia ka lolokukui*, the rape victim was treated. *Ua lolokukui 'ia ke keiki*, the child was sexually molested.
- lō.lō.kuli.** n. Deafness, as from disease. See ex., 'ā'a 1.
