

- lula ho'o.keoni.mana.** n. Rules of gentlemanly conduct, etiquette.
- lula kumu.** n. Fundamental or basic rule.
- lū.lana.** Same as *lū.lā*. See ex., *kalakala 'ihi. Lū.lana ihola ka pihe* (UL 288), the shouting quieted. *Ku'u hoa lū.lana i ka lipolipo*, my peaceful companion in the forest depth.
- lula 'ole.** vs. Disorderly, unruly, without manners, uncouth.
- Lū-lau-kō.** n. Name of a rain associated with Kaua'i. *Lit.*, rain that scatters sugar-cane leaves.
- lule.** 1. vi. To quiver, as jello; to sag, as flesh of a fat person; weak, flexible. (PCP *lule*.) 2. n. A variety of *pili* grass.
- lū-lehua.** n. A red tapa design.
- lū lehua.** v. To scatter *lehua* flowers, said poetically of rain.
- lule.lule.** Redup. of *lule* 1. (PCP *lulelule*.)
- luli.** vi. To shake, as the head in approval or disapproval; to pitch and roll, as a ship; to totter, be unsteady; to sway to and fro (Mat. 11.7), wag. *'Ohe luli i ka makani*, bamboo swaying in the breeze. Cf. *'āluli. ho'o.luli*. To rock, as a child; to shake, as a drink; to sway. Cf. *mōhai ho'oluli*. (PCP *luli*.)
- luli.luli.** Redup. of *luli*; agitated. **ho'o.luli.luli.** Redup. of *ho'oluli*; to agitate. *Waiū ho'oluliluli*, milk shake. (PCP *luliluli*.)
- lulo.** A rare word used to describe a fearless and physically perfect chief, used with *napa* and a negative. (For. 6:463, 488.) Pronunciation uncertain.
- lū.lō.** n. Lei of braided leaves or ferns. Cf. *And*.
- luloni.** To sleep soundly. (AP.)
- lulu.** nvi. Calm, peace, shelter, lee, protection, shield, cloak; to lie at anchor; to be calm; to shield. Cf. *lulu ali'i, pālulu. E lulu hiwalani ana 'oe* (chant), you are sheltering the royal favorite. *Lulu 'ia ke kai* (Nak. 72), the sea has calmed. **ho'o.lulu.** (a) To lie quietly in calm water, as a ship in port; to be calm; to gather together, as objects, or to wait, as for transportation. See *kahua ho'olulu. Ki'i lā'au ho'olulu* (Kam. 64:18), fixed wooden images [as at Hale o Keawe]. *Hale ho'olulu*, depot, waiting station. *Ho'olulu lei*, to offer leis on an altar; the prayer uttered while making an offering of leis; *lit.*, to make leis repose in peace and quiet. (PPN *ruru*.) (b) To chum, for fish; this type of fishing and fisherman.
- lū.lū.** 1. Redup. of *lū* 1; to scatter, sow, as seeds; to fan, winnow; to shake, as dice or the hands, or as an earthquake. Cf. *ha'alulu. Hele akula kekahi kanaka lū.lū hua e lū.lū* (Mat. 13.3), a sower of grain went forth to sow. (PPN *ruuru*.) 2. nvt. Donation, offering, as in church; to make an offering. 3. n. Raffle, lottery.
- lulua.iele.** Redup. of *luaiele*.
- lulu.ā.ina.** 1. n. Freckles. *Luluā'ina 'ole*, without a freckle, said of one well-cared for in childhood who grows up handsome, gracious, and agreeable. 2. v. To pound *'ina* and *hā'uke'uke* sea urchins as for bait.
- lulu ali'i.** n. Royal feather cloak (*rare*); chiefly protection.
- lū.lū.he'e.** Redup. of *lūhe'e*.
- luluhi.** 1. Redup. of *luhi* 1, 2. *Ua luluhi nā maka*, the eyes are heavy with sleep. **ho'o.luluhi.** To make sleepy; drowsy. *Mele ho'oluluhi*, lullaby. 2. Black and heavy, of clouds; overcast, threatening. (AP.)
- lū.lū.hua.** nv. Sower; to sow seeds.
- luluka.** n. Peace, calm. *Rare*.
- lū.lū.lima.** nv. To shake hands; handshake.
- lululu.** Redup. of *lulu*; dead calm, great calm; becalmed; hanging limp, as a sail in a calm.
- lulumī.** Redup. of *lumi* 1; crushed, crumpled, wrinkled. *E lulumī ana nā 'ale o Kaunā* (chant), the billows of Kaunā rush pell-mell. *Huki i ke kalo nui, lulumī i ka lepo ā popo'i i ka mau'u*, pull up the big taro, press the earth firmly and cover with grass.
- lulu'u.** Same as *lu'ulu'u* 1; said also of a tree laden with fruit, a person laden with leis. **ho'o.lulu'u.** Same as *ho'olu'ulu'u*; to cause to bend down, to load heavily.
- Pākaukau i ho'olulu'u pū me nā mea 'ai*, tables laden down with food.
- luma.** Same as *luma'i*.
- luma.ha'i.** n. 1. Certain twist of the fingers in making string figures, perhaps named for a place on Kaua'i. 2. A medicine. (Kam. 64:110.)
- luma'i.** vt. To douse, duck; to upset, tumble, capsize, as in the surf. *Fig.*, to destroy, overwhelm, as with trouble (*luma + -a'i* or *-i*, transitivizers: Gram. 6.6.4). *Luma'i 'ia ke kauā*, the *kauā* (outcast) was drowned. *Ua luma'i 'ia kona mana'olana e nā pilikia*, his hopes were dashed by his troubles. *Luma'i 'ia e ka nalu*, rolled by the waves. (PCP *lumaki*.)
- luma'ia.** Pas/imp. of *luma'i*; capsized.
- luma.ina.** n. Drowning, etc. See *luma'i*.
- luma.kika, rumatika.** n. Rheumatism, arthritis, neuritis. *Eng.*
- luma.luma'i.** Redup. of *luma'i*.
- lū.manawa.hua.** nvi. Stomach disorder accompanied by gas and looseness of the bowels; to suffer thus. Cf. *manawahua*.
- lumi.** 1. vt. To crowd uncomfortably; to overturn, pound, crush, as the surf; to press; to be overwhelmed with trouble; to destroy by black magic. Cf. *lulumī*. 2. Also *rumi*. n. Room, cell. *Eng. Nui ka lumi*, plenty of room.
- lumia.** Pas/imp. of *lumi* 1. *Lumia e ke kahuna 'anā'anā*, destroyed by an *'anā'anā* sorcerer.
- lumi'aina.** n. Dining room.
- lumi'au'au.** n. Bathroom. *Lit.*, washing room.
- lumi hā.iki.** n. Narrow room, cell.
- lumi ho'āhu.** n. Storeroom.
- lumi holoi.** n. Laundry room.
- lumi ho'o.kipa.** n. Parlor, living room, lobby. *Lit.*, entertaining room.
- lumi ho'o.luana.** n. Lounge, reception room.
- lumi hula.hula.** n. Ballroom.
- lumi kuke.** n. Kitchen. *Lit.*, cooking room.
- lumi.lumi.** Same as *lulumī*. *Lumilumi 'ia lāua e ka 'ona o ka 'awa*, they were overcome by the intoxication of the kava.
- lumi moe.** n. Bedroom. *Lit.*, sleeping room.
- lumi waiho pā.** n. Pantry. *Lit.*, room for leaving plates.
- lumi waiho ukana.** n. Storeroom. *Lit.*, room to leave goods.
- luna.** 1. loc. n. High, upper, above, over, up; on, in, to, into. *Luna* follows particles as *ā, i, kō, ma-, mai, no, o*. (Gram. 8.6.) *I luna o*, on top of, over, upon. *Kau i luna o ke ka'a*, get into the car. (PPN *lunga*.) 2. n. Foreman, boss, leader, overseer, supervisor, headman, officer of any sort, commissioner, superintendency, control, rule. *Ka mea iāia ka luna* (For. 6:4), the superintendency. **ho'o.luna.** To appoint as foreman, officer, etc.; to act as officer. 3. Chief piece in the *kōnane* game. (*And*.)
- luna 'ae male.** n. Officer who permits marriage (1851 term).
- luna 'aha.aina.** n. Toastmaster, director of a feast. (Ioane 2.8.)
- luna 'ai.** n. Food inspector.
- luna ana 'aina nui.** n. Surveyor general.
- luna 'ā.nela.** n. Archangel. (Iuda 9.)
- luna 'ā.pono.** n. Censor, approving officer.
- luna 'au.hau.** n. Tax collector (Luka 7.34), tax assessor, publican, master of tribute.
- luna au.puni.** n. Government official.
- luna awa.** n. Harbor master.
- luna 'ekale.sia.** n. Alderman, lay church official.
- luna ha'i.** n. Confessor, as Catholic priest. *Lit.*, speaking superior.
- luna hale kia'i.** n. Commander or chief guard of a fortress.
- luna hana.** n. Overseer, foreman, anyone in charge of work.
- luna haneli.** n. Centurion. (Oih. 10.1.) *Lit.*, overseer of hundred.
- luna helu.** n. Census taker. *Lit.*, counting supervisor.
