

- moe hili.na'i.** nvi. Reclining chair, deck chair, chaise longue; to sleep in a reclining position, as in such a chair.
- moe ho'o.lana.** vi. To doze.
- moe 'ino.** nvi. Nightmare; bad dream; to toss, turn while sleeping, have a nightmare.
- moe ipo.** nv. To have an affair; to sleep with a lover; to commit adultery; fornicator (1 Kor. 6.9). *Huaka'i moe ipo* (PH 16), a match-making mission, a mission for the purpose of arranging for a lover.
- moe.kā'a.** n. Trundle bed.
- moe.kahi.** 1. vi. To sleep alone. 2. vi. To lie or incline in the same direction, of several; in order, sequence. *Moekahi ka hana*, the work is going ahead. 3. n. A maile, before it forms branches.
- moe.kā.hua.** Same as *moe 'ino*.
- moe kama.li'i.** n. Child's crib or bed.
- moe koke.** vi. To go to bed early, to sleep quickly.
- moe.kolohe.** nv. Adultery; to commit adultery, fornicate; adulterous. *Lit.*, illegal mating. *Na'au moekolohe* (Ezek. 6.9), whorish heart. **ho'o.moe.kolohe.** To lead into adultery.
- moe.kolu.** vs. Striped, of three colors of about the same width and lying parallel. Cf. *moelua*.
- moe.kū.** n. Bed.
- moe.kuhua.** n. Viscous matter in the eyes. Cf. *hū'alu*.
- moe.lawa.** Same as *leleiona*, shark sucker.
- moe lepo.** nvi. Earth sleeper; to sleep in the earth. *Fig.*, the dead; dirty, shiftless individual.
- Moe-lehua.** n. Rain name.
- moe lewa.** n. Hammock, cradle. *Lit.*, swinging bed.
- moe like.** vi. To sleep in a similar way; parallel.
- moe loa.** vi. To oversleep, sleep a long time.
- moe.lola.** n. Striped tapa; an outer sheet (*kilohana*) for bed covers, as made by laying a red cloth or tapa over a white tapa in long panels with intervening white spaces, and then beating it into the tapa; striped. Cf. *pa'i'ula*.
- moe.lua.** vs. Striped, of two colors of about same width and lying parallel, as of tapa. Cf. *moekolu, weke*.
- moe lū.au'i.** nv. Mating of child with its parent, as by Wakea and Ho'ohoku-ka-lani; to mate thus.
- moe luli.luli.** n. Cradle. *Lit.*, rocking bed.
- moe ma'i.** nvi. To lie abed sick; bedridden; sickbed. *Ua lō'ihī ka moe ma'i o Koma*, Tom has been sick in bed for a long time.
- moe make.** vi. To lie at death's door; to be sick unto death; to lie in a dead faint.
- moe mau.** vi. To live with a mate out of wedlock; spouse. *Lit.*, constant mating. Cf. *moekolohe*, a short affair, and *noho manuahi*.
- moe.moe.** 1. nvi. Ambush, to lie in ambush; to lurk. **ho'o.moe.moe.** To cause to lie down; to hush or put to sleep; to arrange a match; to set a line or net; to pretend to sleep. Cf. *ho'omoe*. *'Upena ho'omoemoe*, net set in the sea. (PPN *mohemohe*.) 2. vi. To sleep (a rare plural). *Iā moemoe a'e lāua* (GP 46), then the two slept together. 3. Same as *hōlua*, sled.
- moe.moe.ā.** nvi. To dream or fancy; fantasy; dream of a cherished wish, whether good or bad.
- moena.** 1. n. Mat. Cf. *moe*, to lie down. (PPN *moenga*.) 2. n. Couch, bed. 3. n. Resting place, position of anything lying down; place for setting (*ho'omoe*) a fish net. *Na ka lawai'a e kuhikuhi i ka moena e ho'omoe ai i ka 'upena*, the fisherman points out the place to set the net. 4. Same as *moe* 6. *Moena i mua*, to forge ahead.
- moena 'ahu 'ao.** See *'ahu 'ao*.
- moena 'ahu li'i.** n. Fine mat. *Lit.*, fine garment mat.
- moe naha.** See *naha* 2.
- moena hī.nalo, moena hī.nano.** n. Very fine mat made of the bracts of *hala* blossoms (*hīnalo*).
- moena kau pā.kau.kau.** n. Table mat, place mat.
- moena kua.kuai kā.ma'a.** n. Door mat.
- moena lau.** n. Mat made with wide wefts.
- moena pā.wehe.** n. Fine mat, woven in patterns, as on Ni'ihau.
- moena pū.'ao.** See *pū'ao*.
- moena pulu niu.** n. Door mat, foot mat, so called because its fibers suggested coconut husk (*pulu niu*).
- moena wele.weka.** n. Soft carpet of any kind. *Lit.*, velvet (*Eng.*) mat.
- moe.one.** 1. n. Small worm that hides in the sand. 2. Same as *pāki'i*, flounder. *Lit.*, sand lying.
- moe 'opi.'opi.** n. Folding cot or bed, camp bed.
- moe pai.pai.** n. Cradle. *Lit.*, rocking bed.
- moe.pi'o.** nvt. Union of brother and sister of high rank; to make such a marriage. (Malo 54.) *Lit.*, bent marriage, supposedly of a thing bent against itself. Also *pi'o* 2. Cf. *nī'aupi'o*.
- moe.po'o.** vs. Determined. *Lit.*, lay [the] head. *E moe-po'o aku ana au ā hiki i ke kō 'ana o ko'u makemake*, I'll keep right on until my desire is fulfilled.
- moepū. ho'o.moe.pū.** To place artefacts with the dead. *Mai lawe wale i nā mea i ho'omoepū 'ia*, don't wantonly take things placed with the dead. *Lit.*, put to sleep with.
- moe.pū loa.** vi. To offer oneself as a death companion. (Nānā 133.)
- moe.pu'u.** n. Victim slain at the secret burial of a chief, so as to reduce the number of witnesses; victim who commits suicide or has himself killed in order to show love for a dead chief; death. *Lit.*, lie [in a] heap. (Malo 226.)
- moe.'uhane.** nvt. Dream; to dream. *Lit.*, soul sleep.
- moe.'uhane ho'o.pahulu.** See *pahulu*.
- moe 'u'uku.** n. Cot, small bed, camp bed.
- moe wa'a.** nv. A dream of a canoe, formerly considered bad luck. *Fig.*, bad luck, disappointment; to dream thus or have bad luck.
- mohā.** vs. Bright, clear, shining. *Rare*.
- mō.hā.** 1. vs. Fully developed, as a flower; spreading widely, as plants; of fine physique, as a person. 2. See *koloa mōhā*.
- mō.hā.hā.** 1. Redup. of *mōhā* 1. *Mōhāhā kāna kalo*, his taros are well filled out. *E ulu ana me ka mōhāhā o kona mau lālā i nā lau uliuli*, growing with branches spreading wide with green leaves. 2. Redup. of *mōhā*, bright.
- moha.hala.** Same as *mōhalahala*.
- mō.hai.** nvt. Sacrifice, offering; to offer a sacrifice. Cf. *hai, hai'au*.
- Mō.ha'i.** 1. n. Star name (KL line 1890), perhaps Sirius. 2. (*Not cap.*) To break, as a stick. (*And.*)
- mō.hai ahi.** n. Burnt offering. (Puk. 29.25.)
- mō.hai 'ai.** n. Meat offering (Puk. 40.29); food offering.
- mō.hai aloha.** n. Free-will offering (Kanl. 12.6); love offering.
- mō.hai hala.** n. Trespass offering (Oihk. 7.37); sin offering, offering that a sin may be forgiven.
- mō.hai ho.'āli.** n. Wave offering. (Puk. 29.24.)
- mō.hai ho'o.kō.** n. Offering or sacrifice in fulfillment of a vow, or after a wish has been granted. (Nah. 15.3.)
- mō.hai ho'o.luli.** n. Wave offering.
- mō.hai ho'o.malu.** n. Peace offering. (Oihk. 3.3.)
- mō.hai ka'i.kā'i.** n. Priest's portion (RSV), heave offering (KJV). (Puk. 29.27.)
- mō.hai kai.keā.** n. Offering of fat, by fire. (Oihk. 10.15.)
- mō.hai kala hewa.** n. Expiatory offering to atone for sins. *Lit.*, offering for forgiveness of sins.
- mō.hai kuni.** n. Burnt offering. (Nah. 15.8.)
- mō.hai lawe.hala.** n. Sin offering. (Oihk. 4.3.)
- mō.hai makana.** n. Free-will offering (Puk. 25.2), gift offering.
- mō.hai manawa.le'a.** n. Free-will offering.
- mō.hai mili.lani.** n. Sacrifice of thanksgiving.
- mō.hai ola.** nv. Life sacrifice; to offer alive, to sacrifice one's life, as of Christ.
- mō.hai pā.na'i.** n. Substitute sacrifice, as *uluā* (a fish) instead of a human being.
- mō.hai poni.** n. Offering of consecration. (Oihk. 7.37.)
