

- implore. *Noi mau*, to ask constantly, nag, importunate. **ho'o.noi**. Caus/sim. (PPN *no'i*.)
- no'i.au**. Var. of *no'eau*. *No'iau ka hoe a Ka-moho-ali'i* (PH x), skillful was the paddling of Ka-moho-ali'i.
- noi.ele**. vs. Shaken, beaten, as by wind. *I noiele, i ka 'ia e ka Lawakua, niua loloka'a ke po'o o Hanalei* (chant), shaken, beaten by the Lawakua wind, the head of Hanalei [Valley] reels with dizziness.
- noi hele**. vi. Going about asking or begging from place to place.
- noi'i**. vi. To seek knowledge or information; to investigate; investigation, examination, research, searching for even the smallest detail. *'Auhau noi'i*, a tax on every last item. *Kōmike noi'i*, reference committee.
- noi.'ina**. n. Investigation, search, etc.
- noi kū**. vt. To ask rudely, abruptly, point-blank.
- noili**. Same as *no'eau*. *Rare*.
- noi male (mare)**. nvt. Proposal of marriage; to propose marriage.
- noi.noi**. Redup. of *noi*.
- no'i.no'i**. 1. n. Young of *kawakawa*, bonito. Usually called *kīna'u*. 2. vs. Small, dwarfish, stunted. *Rare*.
- noio**. n. Hawaiian noddy tern (*Anous tenuirostris melanogenys*), smaller than noddy tern; subspecies is widespread in the Central Pacific. Also *'eki'eki, laehina*. (PCP *noio*.)
- noi'o**. Var. of *noi'i*.
- noio kō.hā**. n. Noddy tern (*Anous stolidus pileatus*), larger than the tern, *noio*; sooty, except top of head, which is light gray. The name is possibly from *noio kōhāhā*, plump *noio*.
- noka, nota**. n. Note. *Eng.* Also *noka kālā, nota dala*.
- nō.kali, notari**. nvt. Notary; to notarize. *Eng.* *Nōkali no ka lehulehu*, notary public.
- no ka mea**. idiom. Because, whereas (in legal documents), thereby; in informal correspondence, introducer of paragraphs with little meaning. (Gram. 9.11.) *Lit.*, because of the thing. (PCP *no te mea*.)
- nō ka 'oi**. This common sequence can only follow nouns, as in *Mauī nō ka 'oi*, Maui indeed is the best. See *'oi* 2.
- noke**. nvt. To persist, continue, repeat, persevere, keep on; perseverance, persistence. See ex., *'e'elekū. E noke kāua i ka hana, a pau kēia*, let's persist in the work until this is finished. *Noke i ka nuku*, keep on scolding.
- ho'o.noke**. Caus/sim.
- nokea**. Pas/imp. of *noke*.
- nō.kea**. 1. Var. of *nākea*, a goby. 2. vs. White-spotted, as the *nākea*, a fish.
- noke'a**. vs. Overstuffed with food; filled, as a cup to the brim; packed full. *Rare*.
- no ke aha?** idiom. Why? See *aha*. (Gram. 9.11.) (PEP *no te afa*.)
- noke.kula, noketura**. n. Water hen (RSV), swan (KJV). (Kanl. 14:16.)
- nō.kele, notere**. Same as *nōkali*. *Eng.*
- nokema, notema**. n. Juniper roots.
- noke.noke**. Redup. of *noke*. *Nokenoke i ke 'aki i ke ku'i*, continued grinding of the teeth.
- nō.kī**. vs. Deep. *I loko nōkī o ka 'ōpū, wāwahi hua o ka lani* (chant), though deep within the womb, a high chief would break forth. *Kau nōkī ka mana'o*, concentrate deeply.
- noko.noko**. nvi. Nervous anticipation and sensation that one is going to cough; to have such.
- noku**. Var. of *loku*.
- nokule**. 1. vs. Numb. *Noho i ka wai a nokule ka 'ili*, staying in the water until the skin was numbed. 2. Same as *kukule*, listless. *Rare*.
- noku.noku**. Var. of *lokuloku*.
- nō.la'e.la'e**. Same as *māla'ela'e*, clear. (For. 6:378.)
- no laila**. See *laila*.
- nole**. 1. vs. Sickly, unhealthy. *Rare*. Cf. *mīnole, nīnole*. 2. vt. To annoy by overfamiliarity. *Rare*. Cf. *hole, pīhole*.
- nole. ho'o.nole**. Awkward, without skill. *Rare*.
- Nole.wai, Norewai**. nvs. Norway; Norwegian. *Eng.*
- Nole.weke, Noreweke**. nvs. Norwegian. *Eng.*
- noiliki**. nvs. Northeast. *Eng.*
- nō.lino.lino**. Var. of *'ōlinolino*, shiny. *'Ano nōlinolino ka 'i'o kanaka i ke ahi* (chant), human flesh is somewhat shiny in the fire [light].
- nolo**. 1. vs. Filled full, crowded. *Nolo ka wa'a i ka i'a; nolo ka 'lilo i ka 'uku*, the canoe is full of fish; the dog is full of fleas. 2. Same as *nonō*.
- nolo.nolo**. Redup. of *nolo*.
- nolu**. 1. vs. Springy, elastic, soft, yielding, boggy. Cf. *holu*. *Nolu ka ihu o Hōpoe i ka makani*, yielding is the nose of Hōpoe [rock] to the wind [of a balancing rock]. **ho'o.nolu**. Caus/sim. 2. vt. To cheat, deceive. *No ke aha lā 'oukou e nolu mai ai ā puni mākou* (Ios. 9.22), why have you beguiled us? (PEP *ngolu*.)
- nolu.ā.kaua**. Traitor; one born under one chief who fights for another. (And.)
- nolu ehū**. vs. Softened and wet with mist and rain, as upland ferns. *Nolu ehū luhe i ka palai* (song), a soft mist dripping on drooping *palai* fern.
- nolu.nolu**. Redup. of *nolu* 1, 2. *Mau'u nolunolu kohu lolo weleweka*, soft grass like velvet cloth.
- nolunolu. ho'o.nolu.nolu**. A name for the straight portion of a canoe rim. (For. 5:612-3.)
- nolu pē**. vs. 1. Graceful bending, swaying, as of shrubs. 2. Drenched. *Ohaoha pua i ka wai, i ka nolu pē i ka ua* (song), flowers thrive in the water, softened and drenched by the rain.
- nome**. vt. To eat a little at a time for a long time, as horses eating grass; to munch along; revolving or rolling along, as a wheel. See chant, *melu* 1. *'Ohi'āhā mai ana eā, ke nome a'ela iā Puna eā* (song for Pele), shish shish here [the fires of Pele], eating munching along through Puna. **ho'o.nome**. To cause to munch, move along.
- nomea**. Pas/imp. of *nome*.
- nome.nome**. Redup. of *nome*. **ho'o.nome.nome**. Redup. of *ho'onome*; to move the lips silently, as though speaking to oneself. *E ho'onomenome 'oe i kō waha ā hiki i ka wā e pau ai ku'u oli 'ana*, mouth your words until I finish my chant.
- nona**. n-poss. His, hers, its, for him, for her, for it (o-form, Gram. 9.11). *Ke kanaka nona ka pāpale i lawe 'ia*, the man whose hat was taken. (PCP *nona*.)
- nona.nona**. n. 1. Ant (same as more common *naonao*). *Ka-nonanona*, (Hawaiian newspaper 1841-5), the ant (see *'ānonanona*). 2. Gnat. 3. Many, a great many. *Nonanona kānaka i kahaone* (Kel. 141), crowds of people on the beach.
- none**. vs. 1. Slow, tedious, time-consuming. **ho'o.none**. To work slowly and with disinterest; to be a slowpoke. 2. Patience-trying, teasing, annoying, fretting; to tease, nag.
- nonea**. Same as *none* 1, 2. *He nonea kēia 'ano hana*, this kind of work is tedious, annoying.
- none.ā**. n. Distaste for food that one has had too much of, as fats; surfeit. (Gram. 6.5.)
- none.nea**. Same as *nonenonea*.
- none.none**. Redup. of *none* 1, 2.
- none.nonea**. Redup. of *nonea*.
- noni**. 1. n. The Indian mulberry (*Morinda citrifolia*), a small tree or shrub in the coffee family, a native of Asia, Australia, and islands of the Pacific. Leaves are large, shiny, deep-veined. Many small flowers are borne on round heads, which become pale-yellow unpleasant-tasting fruits. Formerly Hawaiians obtained dyes and medicine from many parts of the tree. (Neal 804.) See *kōhi* 1, *pūhai*. (PPN *nonu*, PCP *nono*, but Marquesan *noni*.) 2. vs. Troubled, agitated, perplexed, confused. **ho'o.noni**. To create a disturbance, cause trouble, incite. 3. Same as *'ānoni*, to mix. Cf. *manoni*. *Rare*. 4. nvi. Poor appetite, as of an invalid; to take food unwillingly. *Rare*.
- noni kua.hiwi**. n. Native trees (*Morinda trimera* and *M.*
