- noni.noni.** Redup. of *noni*.
- noni.nui.** n. Soft, pinkish porous stone, as used in polishing.
- nono.** vs. 1. Red, redness; rosy-cheeked; red-faced, as from sunburn; sunburned, bronzed. *Nono 'ula*, to flush, blush. Cf. *pūnono*. 2. Full of holes, perforated, moth-eaten; oozing, seeping out, as water in the sand; seepage. Cf. *hānonono*.
- nonō.** vi. To snore, gurgle. **ho'o.nonō.** Caus/sim.
- nono.ā, nonowā.** Var. of *lonōā*, rumor.
- nō.noē.noē.** Same as *noenoe*.
- nonohē.** vs. Attractive, beautiful. *Lehua, 'o ka lehua maka noe, ua nonohē wale i Haua'iliki* (chant for Haku-o-Hawai'i), *lehua*, misty-faced *lehua*, beautiful at Haua'iliki.
- nonohi.** Redup. of *nohi*.
- nono.hia.** Pas/imp. of *nono 1*.
- nono.hina.** n. Blossoms of the *olopua*, a tree.
- nonoho.** Redup. and plural of *noho*. *Ke nonoho like maila nā ao 'ōpua*, the cloud banks are sitting together. (PPN *nonofo*.)
- nonohu.** Same as *'o'ohu*, stooped.
- nono.hua.** nvi. Diarrhea; to have symptoms of diarrhea; disgust; to be vile. *'Oia ia mau 'ōpala o ka mana'o nonohua* (Kel. 26), such was the rubbish of vile thoughts.
- nono.huā, nonohuwā.** nvs. Jealous; jealousy, quick-tempered jealousy. **ho'o.nono.huā.** To nurse jealousy and ill will; to hate.
- nonoi.** Redup. of *noi*. *Nonoi no ka manawa*, ask for temporarily, borrow. (PEP *nono'i*.)
- nono.i'i.** Same as *no'ino'i*, stunted.
- nono.keā.** See *puhi nonokea*.
- nono.lau.** Var. of *lonolau*.
- nonolo.** 1. Redup. of *nolo*; purring. 2. Defeated in war. (AP.)
- nonolu.** Redup. of *nolu*.
- nonome.** Redup. of *nome*. *Ho'ohie ka mana'o no ka huila, ka nonome ho'ola'i i ka 'ilikai* (song), thinking with happy pride of the wheel [of the vessel], rolling quietly along on the surface of the sea.
- nono.mēa.** vs. Reddish.
- nono.nēa.** vt. To redden, as the cheeks with *'ōlena* or *'alaea*.
- nononi.** Redup. of *noni*.
- nonono.** Redup. of *nono 1, 2*.
- nono.noā.** Redup. of *nonoā*.
- nono.noho.** Redup. of *nonoho*. *Nononoho a moe nā keiki* (chant for Kua-kini), dwelt together and mated were the children.
- nono.nokē.** Redup. and plural of *nokē*.
- nono'o.** Var. of *no'ono'o*.
- nono.papa.** nvs. Invalid, sick. *Rare*.
- nono.wā.** Var. spelling of *nonoā*.
- nonu.** Var. of *nolu*.
- no'o.** Same as *no'ono'o*. *Rare*.
- no'oa.** Pas/imp. of *no'o*.
- no'olu.** Same as *'olu'olu*. *Rare*.
- no'olua.** poss. For you, belonging to you (dual, *o*-class).
- no'o.no'o.** nvt. Thought, reflection, thinking, meditation; to think, reflect, meditate, concentrate; to consider, as a case at law; thoughtful, mental. Cf. *mana'o, no'ono'o 'ole. No'ono'o makua*, to be thoughtful and considerate of parents and elders, filial. *No'ono'o pono*, to think carefully, meditate, concentrate. *No'ono'o mua*, to anticipate, estimate (see *'ōlelo no'ono'o*). *No'ono'o hāiki*, narrow-minded; a narrow mind. *No'ono'o laulā*, broad-minded. *No'ono'o nui*, to think much, concentrate, meditate; meditation. **ho'o.no'o.no'o.** To cause to think, reflect; reminiscent, recalling to mind, remembering. Cf. more common *ho'omana'o*.
- no'o.no'o 'ole.** nvs. Thoughtless, irresponsible, heedless, unconcerned, without thinking, carefree, careless; thoughtlessness. Also *'a'ohē no'ono'o. Ua hele aku au me ka no'ono'o 'ole i ka hopena*, I went without considering the consequences.
- no'o.no'o ulu wale.** n. Imagination, impulse. *Lit.*, thought growing by itself.
- no'ou.kou.** poss. For you, belonging to you (plural, *o*-class).
- nopa.** 1. vs. Lazy, slow. *Rare*. 2. Crooked. (And.)
- nopa.nopa.** Redup. of *nopa 1*.
- nō.pili.** Var. of *nāpili*, a fish.
- nō.polo.** Same as *nīpolo*. *Rare*.
- nopu.** 1. nvs. To swell; sprouting, plump. *Fig.*, to spring up in the mind, as a thought or desire. See ex., *'ae 3. Nopu maila ka mana'o e hele aku i ou lā*, the thought has come to go to you. 2. vs. Hot, as from the sun or fire. *I ka lā ikiiki nopu i ke one* (song), in the hot sun warming the sand.
- nopue.** Var. of *nopu 1*.
- nopu.nopu.** Redup. of *nopu*.
- nopu'u.** n. Child. *Ni'ihau*.
- nou.** 1. nvt. To throw, pelt, cast, pitch, hurl; buffeting, throwing; pitcher. *'O ka ho'oili i ka ihu o ka wa'a a nou i ke kai* (chant), to conduct the prow of the canoe until it beats into the sea. *Lehua maka nou i ke ahi* (chant by Hi'iaka), *Lehua* face pelted by the fire. **ho'o.nou.** To throw, pelt; to put forth physical effort; to strain; to pretend or cause to throw. Cf. *ha'anou*. 2. *n*-poss. For you, yours, in your honor (*o*-form, singular; Gram. 9.11). (PCP *no(o)u*.)
- no'u.** 1. nvs. Short, thickset, plump but not tall (said more often of plants than of humans). A short, stocky *koa* tree suitable for a wide, short canoe was also called *no'u*. 2. n. A native variety of banana, bearing small bunches of thick, round fruit, eaten raw or cooked, the skin yellow, the flesh cream-colored. 3. vi. To eat greedily with great mouthfuls, even when no longer hungry. Cf. *nu'u*. 4. *n*-poss. For me, mine, in my honor (*o*-form, Gram. 9.11). *No'u kēlā*, give that to me. (PCP *no(o)ku*.)
- no'u.** See *ha'ano'u*.
- no'ū.** vs. Suffused with water; drenched, as with rain; moist and fragrant, as a flower in the rain or dew.
- noua.** Pas/imp. of *nou 1*.
- noulu.** Var. of *loulu*, a palm.
- nou.nou.** Redup. of *nou 1*.
- no'u.no'u.** 1. Redup. of *no'u 1, 3*. 2. n. A variety of gourd with a short (*no'u*) fruit. Also *pāha'aha'a, pākākā*.
- nou.nou pū.niu.** n. Game of throwing tapa balls at suspended coconut shells.
- nowēke.** n. Northwest. *Eng.*
- nowelo.** Var. spelling of *noelo*.
- Nowe.mapa.** n. November. *Eng.*
- nō.weo.** vs. Bright, shiny. *'Ula nōweo ka lā i ka pua 'ilima* (song), the sun is bright and scarlet on the *'ilima* blossom.
- Nō.weo-'ula.** n. Rain name associated with Nā-pili, West Maui.
- nū.** 1. nvi. To cough; to roar, as wind; grunting, as of pigs; cooing, as of doves; patter, as of rain; groaning, deep sighing, moaning; mentally agitated, worried, grief-stricken. *Ka ua nū hele ma ka moana*, the rain coming pattering over the open sea. **ho'o.nū.** To moan, groan, sigh, hum, roar, etc. *Ka ua 'awa'awa e ho'onū lā i uka*, the bitterly cold rain pattering in the uplands. (PPN *nguu*.) 2. Short for *nuku*, beak. See *'alae nū kea*. 3. Same as *lū 1*, to scatter, etc. 4. n. The letter "n". 5. n. News. *Eng.* See *nū hou*. 6. n. Gnu. *Eng.* 7. n. A crescendo followed by a decrescendo in music.
- nu'a.** 1. nvs. Thick; piled one on top of the other, as leis, mats, or ocean swells; heaped; lush, thick-growing; much traveled, as a road; multitude, as of people,
