

- numi.** vi. To subside gradually, as tears, laughter, emotions. *Numi maila kona kaumaha*, his sorrows gradually ebbed away. (PCP *numi*.)
- numo.nia.** n. Pneumonia. *Eng.*
- nuna.** 1. Rare var. of *luna*, above. 2. n. Nun. *Eng.*
- nuna.nuna.** Same as *nupanupa*.
- nū.nū.** nvi. Speculation; to wonder, speculate, discuss and wonder about. *Ia wā noho ihola lākou me ka nūnē aku a nūnē mai*, then they sat and asked wondering questions of each other.
- nū.nēa.** Same as *nūnē*.
- nunele, nunere.** n. Nunnery, convent. *Eng.*
- nunoi.** n. According to Emerson, the "posterior fontanelle" of Haumea from which Hi'iaka was born as a clot of blood. (PH X.)
- nunu.** 1. nvt. Greed; to covet, extort, take property by force. Cf. *'ālunu*, *'ānunu*, *lunu*. (Perhaps PPN -*nu*; cf. Tongan *mānu-*, to be always wanting.) 2. vt. Swollen, puffed up; to swell up; to swathe or roll up, as an article in tapa; to fold, bind. *Ua ho'omaka na'e ke 'ano nunu mai o nā ku'emaka* (Kel. 18), the eyebrows began to be puffed up [raised]. (PPN *ngungu*.)
- nunu. ho'o.nunu.** A seaweed (*Laurencia obtusa* var. *racemosa*). Cf. *līpe'e*.
- nū.nū.** 1. n. Introduced rock pigeon or wild pigeon (*Columba livia*); dove (Mele 2.14). See saying, *dove*. 2. nvi. Moaning, groaning, cooing, grunting; to do so. (PPN *nguunguu*.) 3. n. Trumpet fish (*Aulostomus chinensis*). Also *nuhu*.
- nunu'a.** vs. Crowded, confused, clustering, swarming, assembling promiscuously.
- nunuha.** Redup. of *nuha*; sulky, moody, morose.
- nunuhe.** Redup. of *nuhe* 1.
- nunui.** Plural of *nui* 1.
- nunuki.** vi. To rise and fall, as the sea. *Rare*.
- nunulu.** vi. To growl or snarl, as a dog; warbling, as a bird; reverberating. (PPN *ngungulu*.)
- nupa.** 1. Var. of *lupa*. 2. n. A deep cave or chasm; gloominess, as in a cave. 3. vs. Enlarged, swollen. *Rare*.
- nupai.kini.** vs. New-fashioned. *Eng.*
- nupa.nupa.** Redup. of *nupa* 1-3. Also *lupalupa*. Cf. *hānupanupa*. **ho'o.nupa.nupa.** Same as *ho'olupalupa*. *Ua piha kā kākou mau mele me nā ho'onupanupa 'ana a ia mea, he aloha*, our songs are filled with lush [descriptions] of that thing, *aloha*.
- nū.pēpa.** n. Newspaper *Eng.*
- nū.pēpa puka lā.** n. Daily newspaper.
- nū.polu.polu.** vs. Scattered, thick, as flowers. *'O a'u lehua i 'aina e ka manu a mā.ui i ke kai, nūpolupolu akula i ke kai o Hilo* (prayer to Kapo), my *lehua* blossoms picked by the birds and bruised by the sea, scattered there on the sea of Hilo.
- nū.ponuponu.** Var. of *nūpolupolu*.
- nu'u.** 1. nvs. Height, high place, summit, crest, elevation; the second platform in the *lananu'u mamao*, oracle tower on a heiau; stratum; piled high. *Fig.*, great. *Ka ua nu'u*, torrential rain. *'Ekolu mau nu'u pō* (Kep. 49), three strata of night. *Ua hiki aku i ka nu'u ka mana o Roma*, the power of Rome reached its culminating point. (PPN *nuku*.) 2. Same as *ho'onu'u*. **ho'o.nu'u.** To eat heartily (see saying *ko'u* 1).
- nu'u.anu.** n. Name of a card game. (Ii 127.)
- Nu'u-anu.** n. Place name and star name. *Lit.*, cool heights.
- Nu'u.hiwa.** 1. nvs. Marquesas Islands; Nukuhiva Island in the Marquesas; Marquesan. 2. (*Not cap.*) n. A variety of banana, mistakenly called in English the New Zealand banana.
- nu'u.kole.** Same as *hi'ukole*, a fish.
- nu'u.mamao.** Same as *lananu'u mamao*.
- nu'u.mao.mao.** Rare var. of *nu'u.mamao*.
- nu'u.mela.** Same as *laulele*, milkweed.
- nu'u.pa'a.** Same as *pokipa'a*.
- nu'u.pē.** nvs. A fat person; fat. *Ua ho'i mai nei paha ku'u nu'upē*, perhaps my fat [friend] has come home.
