

pā.ono. vt. By sixes, sixfold; to divide by sixes; to have six or distribute to six. **ho'o.pā.ono.** Caus/sim.

pāo'o. n. Name for several varieties of 'o'opu, especially *Istiblennius zebra*, *Entomacrodus marmoratus* (marbled blenny); also called rockskippers because of their ability to leap across stretches of rocky shoreline. The name may be qualified by the terms *kauila* (*Exallias brevis*, shortbodied blenny), *luahine*, *puhi*. *Pāo'o* figure prominently in legends and for some are 'aumākua. See ex., *ha'apupū*. Also *pāno'o*. (PEP *paoko*.)

pā.'ō.'ō. n. Broken or discarded portions of sweet potatoes; sprouting bits of these fragments.

pao.pao. Redup. of *pao* 1, 2. *Ua paopao 'ia 'oia no kō kākou hala*, he was wounded for our transgressions. *Paopao noho ni'a*, blunt or proud speech [caused by] slander. (PEP *pa'opa'o*.)

pā'o.pā'o, ulua pā'o.pā'o. n. A species of *ulua*, a fish (*Caranx speciosus*); green and yellow with vertical green bands; considered one of the best fishes for eating raw.

Pā-ō.pua. n. Name of a star (no data).

pā.'ou.'ou. n. Name given to young of the *hou*, a fish.

papa. 1. nvs. Flat surface, stratum, plain, reef, layer, level, foundation, story of a building, floor, class, rank, grade, order, table, sheet, plate, shelf (*rare*), face (of a watch); flat, level; to be a great many. Cf. *ali'i papa*, *noho papa* 1, *papa ali'i*. *Kui papa*, to make overlap on a lei, as feathers. *Helu papa*, to recite in consecutive order. *Ne'e papa*, to move in rank. *Kākū papa*, to stand in ranks, as an army. **ho'o.papa.** To place in rank or file; to put in order, to put in layers, overlay, as shingles; to make a shelf; to pack neatly. (PPN *papa*.)

2. nvs. Native-born, especially for several generations (see *noho papa* 2); offspring of the mating of an individual of *pi'o*, *naha*, or *ni'aupi'o* rank, with one of *kaukauali'i* rank; the lowest ranking aristocrat. 3. vs. Set close together, thick together, as of growing plants; in unison, all together. Cf. *holopapa*, *kāpapa*, *ne'epapa*, *papapū*. *He kāhili papa iki*, a feather standard with small feathers. 4. nvs. Board, lumber; wooden. 5. n. A variety of kava. The name may be qualified by the colors 'ele'ele, *kea*. 6. n. Middle portion of a fishing net, bag net. 7. (*Cap.*) n. Wind associated with Honua-'ula, Maui. (For. 5:101.) 8. n. Stone used as sinker for *lāhe'e*, octopus lure. (Malo 19.) 9. n. Wafer. (Puk. 29.2.)

-**papa. ho'o.papa.** Purification of woman after childbirth, involving medicinal herbs bound to the abdomen, and a taboo on sex relations. (Malo 138.)

papā. vi. To blow, as the wind; to sound, echo; to shine, as sun or moon. Cf. *pā* 4. *Papā ka leo o ke kai*, the voice of the sea sounds.

pā.pā. 1. vt. To forbid, prohibit, taboo. *Pāpā 'ana*, prohibition. *Waiwai i pāpā 'ia e ke kānāwai*, contraband goods; *lit.*, goods forbidden by the law. *Ua pāpā au iāia, 'a'ole e hele*, I forbid him to go. 2. vt. To touch, as of two objects; contest (same as *ho'opāpā* [af]). **ho'o.pā.pā.** (a) To touch repeatedly; to feel one's way, as a blind person does; a contest in wit (as riddling) or strength; to hold such a contest; repartee, banter; to endeavor to find out something or obtain something by indirect methods, by feeling out the person indirectly; to debate, argue. (b) A style of guitar playing in which one person strums, and the other touches the strings of the same guitar to produce certain effects; to play thus. (PPN *paapaa*.) 3. n. A small, active green-colored crab, perhaps *Percnon planissimum*. 4. n. Papa (introduced by white missionaries, who thought it rude for children to call father by first name). *Eng.*

pā.pā- Redup. of *pā-*, preceding numerals. (Gram. 10.3.) *Hūnā pāpākanalima a'e iā lākou i loko o ke ana* (1 Nal. 18.4), hid them by fifties in a cave. *Ua pāpāono lākou i nā 'ēheu* (Hoik. 4.8), each of them had six wings. **ho'o.pā.pā-** Redup. of *ho'opā-*. *Rare*.

papa'a. Redup. of *pa'a* 1; tight, secure, especially of a walled stronghold; to hold back. *Hale papa'a*, store-

house. *Nā kūlanakauhale papa'a oo Solomona* (2 Oihk. 8.6), the store cities of Solomon. *E 'ae ho'i 'oe e hā'awi mai i kahi keiki no māua, papa'a mai nei ho'i 'oe*, why not agree to give us two a child, you are just holding back.

pā.pa'a. 1. nvs. Cooked crisp, as pig; overdone, burned, parched; scab, of a sore; crust. Cf. *palaoa pāpa'a*, *pāpa'a palaoa* and saying, *kūmau* 2. 'Ili *pāpa'a lā*, sunburned or tanned skin. 'A'ohē *nao 'ai i ka pāpa'a*, what a calamity to eat the burned food [a calamity]. **ho'o.pā.pa'a.** To make crisp, brittle; to burn, scorch. *Ho'opāpa'a palaoa*, to toast bread. *Palaoa ho'opāpa'a*, toast. Also *pa'apa'a*. (PEP *paka*.) 2. n. Slice, as of bread; uncut piece. Cf. *pāpa'a hao*, *pāpa'a lepo*, *pāpa'a palaoa*, *pāpa'a pelena*. 3. n. Cluster of tiny red and yellow feathers tied together fanwise, as presented to a chief to be used for featherwork. Also *pa'a'a*. 4. n. A red sugar cane with light-brown fibers; it has an odor similar to burnt sugar, hence its name. Used in love sorcery. 5. n. Bark, as of trees. 6. Same as *pāki'i* 2, fish. 7. (*Cap.*) n. Wind names. See below.

pā pa'a. 1. n. A sturdy mother-of-pearl; a strong *pā*. 2. vs. Securely closed, fastened. *Pā pa'a ka pu'u* (Nak. 106), the throat is shut tight [of one who can eat no more].

pā.pa'a hao. n. Scrap iron.

pā.pa'a.hēkili. Same as *huahekili uka*, a shrub. See *pūai-lewa*.

pā.pa'a.hū.pē. n. Dried nasal mucus.

papa 'ai.ana. n. Ironing board.

papa 'aina. n. Dining table; eating mat, as laid on the floor; meal, dinner, mess.

pā.pa'a.'ina. nv. To crackle, snap; crackling, snapping; sharp crack, as of something breaking, or of crackling sound of feet walking over a crusty surface; to crack, as joints; brittle, easily broken. Cf. 'u'ina.

Pā.pa'a Inu Wai. n. A gentle Kaua'i wind with rain that reaches Ni'ihau.

pā.pa'a kai. nvs. Salt-encrusted; salt; coated by sea spray, as plants near the sea.

pā.pa'a kao. n. Slabs of salted and dried goat meat.

pā.pa'a.kea. 1. Same as *pa'akea*, limestone. 2. n. A seaweed (*Liagora valida*), related to *puaki*.

pā.pa'a.koali. n. A sweet potato.

pā.pa'a.kō.nā.hua. n. Entrails, as of a pig. *Rare*.

pā.pa'a kukui. See *pāpa'a* 6.

pā.pa'a lā. vs. Sunburned, tanned; parched, dried up by the sun.

Pā.pa'a Lā. n. A wind similar to Pāpa'a Inu Wai except that it blows in sunny weather, noted at East Maui.

pā.pā.'ale. nvt. Agreement; to agree. *Ka'ū. Ua pāpā'ale lāua i ka hana*, they agreed on the work.

pā.pa'a lepo. n. Clod of dirt. (Ioba 7.5.)

papa ali'i. n. One of the chiefly class; chiefly class. Cf. *ali'i papa*.

pā.pa'a.nā. Same as *pa'apa'anā* 1, 2. *E pāpa'anā mai 'oe e kōkua mai ia'u*, haste thee to help me.

pā.pa'a palaoa. n. Slice of bread. Cf. *palaoa pāpa'a*.

pā.pa'a pelena (berena). n. A whole, unbroken cracker; crust of bread; wafer (Oihk. 8.26).

pā.pa'a piēle. n. Crusty scalp due to eruption of matter.

papa a po'o. Same as *papa po'o*.

pā.pa'a.pū. vs. Cooked to a crisp, burned; crusty, heavily encrusted.

papa.'aua. Redup. of *pa'aua*.

papa 'au.wae. n. Lower jaw. See ex., *nao-ho'opa'i*.

pā.pa'a wela. nvs. A burn; burned; scorched; hardened, as breadfruit on one side.

Papa E'e Moku. n. Board of Immigration.

papa 'ele.'ele. n. 1. Blackboard. 2. See *papa* 1.

pā.pā.hā. Redup. of *pāhā*.

papa hana. n. 1. Work method, plan, stratagem, policy, program, agenda, project; workbench. 'O ka *papa hana kēia a Kua'ua'u*, this is Kua'ua'u's method [that of a famous medical practitioner]. 2. Ceremony for the gods, as in offering kava.
