

- pā.paha.paha.** n. An edible seaweed, *Ulva fasciata*. Also *līpahapaha*, *pahapaha*, *pālahalaha*, *pakaiea*. For other variants, see *līpahapaha*.
- papa.hā.pu'u.** n. A fish, possibly a *hāpu'u* (no data).
- papa he'e nalu.** n. Surfboard. *Lit.*, board [for] sliding waves. *Hā'awi papa he'e nalu*, to give with the understanding that the object will be returned [surfboards were loaned rather than given].
- papa hehi.** n. Footboard, used for dancing; treadle. *Lit.*, board to step on.
- papa.hele.** n. Floor, deck. *Lit.*, walking board.
- papa.hele o luna.** n. Upper floor, upstairs.
- papa helu.** n. Table, list, enumeration, scoreboard, statistics.
- pā.pahi.** nvt. To decorate, honor, confer honors; adornment, decoration. Cf. *lei pāpahi*.
- pā.pā.hiku.** Redup. of *pāhiku*. *Ho'okomo pāpāhiku 'o Noa iā lakou* (song), Noah put them in by sevens.
- papa hī.meni.** n. Choir, choral group.
- papa hō.'ike.** n. Program, timetable, index, schedule, sign, bulletin board, sign board.
- papa.hola.** n. 1. Face of a clock or watch. 2. Level pavement beside a heiau. (Malo 162.) 3. Priests who prohibited noise during taboo. 4. Division of spoils among the victors. *Rare*.
- papa hola.hola kā.nā.wai la'a.** n. Universally sacred decree. (Kam. 64:11.)
- papa hole.** n. Smooth, planed lumber; grooved board for making ribbed tapa.
- papa.holo.** n. Lattice. (2 Nal. 1.2.)
- papa holoi.** n. Washboard.
- papa hō.lua.** n. Sled composed of two narrow runners, 2 to 6 m long, as used for the *hōlua* sport.
- papa honua.** n. Foundation of the earth.
- papa ho'o.holo.** n. Slide plate on a sewing machine.
- papa ho'o.laha.** n. Billboard.
- papa ho'o.lewa.lewa.** Same as *papa lewalewa*.
- Papa Ho'o.na'au.ao.** n. Board of Education.
- Papa Ho'o.pa'a Inoa.** n. Board of Registration. *Lit.*, board to affix names.
- papahu.** Same as *pahu*, stake; to push. See ex., *kanu*.
- papa hulei.** n. Seesaw, teeter.
- papa huli honua.** n. Experts who determined land boundaries.
- papa hulu.hulu.** n. Rough lumber.
- papa hului.** 1. n. Pile, as of winnings, objects. Cf. *hului* 2. 2. Same as *hului*, a fishing net. (Malo 210.)
- pā.pai.** Same as *pō'ou*, fishes.
- papa'i.** 1. Redup. of *pa'i* 1-5. **ho'o.papa'i.** Redup. of *ho'opa'i*; to move the stomach muscles, as in certain hula dances. (PPN *papaki*.) 2. See *hale papa'i*.
- pā.pa'i.** n. 1. General name for crabs. (PPN *papa*, probably PCP *paapaka*.) 2. Small temporary hut or shelter. See below.
- papaia.** Same as *mīkana*, papaya. *Eng.*
- pā.pā.ia.** n. An offering or place for offering, as of kava.
- pā.pa'i 'ai.** n. Cookhouse.
- papai.ā.ulu.** vi. To blow, rise, as a breeze. *Aia ka papai-āulu makani ke kū maila*, there's the breeze coming up over there.
- pā.pāi.'awa, pā.pāia 'awa.** nvi. Ceremonial offering of kava, especially to free one from the necessity of completing an oath or vow; to perform such a ceremony. (Laie 475.)
- pā.pa'i iwi pū.pū.** n. Hermit crab. Also *unauna*, 'ōunauna. *Lit.*, bone shell crab.
- pā.pa'i kahu.** n. Cookhouse. *Lit.*, baking shed.
- pā.pa'i kilu.** n. Shed where *kilu*, a game, was played. (For. 6:197.)
- pā.pa'i kua lēna.lēna.** n. Yellow-backed crab. *Fig.*, experienced warrior.
- pā.pa'i kua loa.** n. The crab commonly called "Kona crab" (*Ranina ranina*). *Lit.*, long-backed crab.
- pā.pa'i kū.honu.** Same as *kūhonu*, a crab.
- papa'i kukui.** Same as *pa'i kukui*.
- pā.pa'i Lā.na'i.** n. A kind of crab. (Malo 45.)
- pā.pa'i lawai'a.** n. Fisherman's hut.
- papa 'ili.'ili.** n. Arrangement of pebbles in the form of a man used for instruction by a *kahuna hāhā*. (Kam 64:108.)
- pā.pa'i limu.** n. A species of crab, probably *Simocarcinus simplex*. *Lit.*, seaweed crab.
- pā.pa'i lī.poa.** Same as *pāpa'i limu*. *Lit.*, *līpoa* (seaweed) crab.
- papai.lua.** Redup. of *pailua*. **ho'o.papai.lua.** Redup. of *ho'opailua*; beginning to be nauseated, first symptoms of nausea.
- pā.pa'i mahi 'ai.** n. Temporary hut of a farmer near plantations.
- papa inoa.** n. List or catalogue of names, register.
- papai.ō.** n. Sacrifice; propitiatory offering or food offering.
- papai.oa.** n. Long reef. *Kū ka hālelo, 'a'aka ka papai-oa* (chant), the jaggedness appears, the coral reef is cracked.
- papa.'iole.** n. Irregularly cut, of hair, said to be named for an irregular haircut given to Pīkoi-a-ka-'alalā (a demigod born of a crow father, who sometimes appeared as a rat) by his rat sisters, and short for *pa'ipa'i 'iole*, rat haircut.
- papa ipu.** n. Shelf for food containers.
- pā.pā.iwa.** Redup. of *pāiwa*.
- pā.pā.kahi.** Redup. of *pākahi*. *Miki pāpākahi*, to dip up poi with one finger.
- papa kahuna.** n. Priestly class.
- pā.pā.kai.** vi. Shoved, pounded by the sea.
- papa kā.kau.** n. Slate, writing board.
- pā.pā.kana-** Prefix to numbers from *kolu* (three) to *iwa* (nine); see *pāpā-*.
- papa kaua.** n. Division of an army; group of men armed with *pololū*, spears, surrounding the king (Malo 204, Emerson note).
- papa kau.kau.** Same as *pākaukau*.
- papa kea.** n. 1. White stratum, sand beach. 2. See *papa* 5, a variety of kava.
- papā.kea.** nvs. White spray, as of sea; to rise in spray; white caps.
- papa ke'e.hana.** Var. of *papa ke'ehina*. (1 Nal. 6.30.)
- papa ke'e.hina.** n. Floor. *Lit.*, trampled stratum.
- papa.kema, bapatema.** n. Baptism. *Eng.* Also *papekema*. *Makua papakema*, godparent. *Keiki papakema*, godchild.
- pā.pā.ki'i.** vi. To sit flat, as on the floor. *Rare*.
- papa koa.** n. 1. Board of wood of *koa*, a tree. 2. Group or band (Oih. 10.1) of soldiers; rank or company of an army.
- pā.pā.kole.** n. Hip, hipbone, buttocks. (For. 4:293, Dan. 5.6.) *He pili pāpākole*, related to in-laws (*lit.*, back-sided relationship; rude because of implication that one is not a true relative).
- papa kō.lea.** n. Plover flats.
- papā.kolea.** vi. To break, of waves. *Rare*.
- pā.pā.kole-kā-wa'a.** Same as *pāpākole koa'e*.
- pā.pā.kole koa'e.** n. A variety of taro, grown chiefly in Kona, Ka'ū and Puna, Hawai'i; plant stocky, petioles red-striped, corm white, used especially for table taro. Cf. *koa'e* 3, a taro.
- pā.pā.kolu.** Redup. of *pākolu*.
- Papa Komi.kina.** n. Board of Commissioners.
- papa-kō.nane.** n. A mat design.
- papa kō.nane.** n. Stone on which the checkerlike game *kōnane* was played.
- papa.kū.** 1. n. Foundation or surface, as of the earth; floor, as of ocean; bed, as of a stream; bottom. *Papakū kia*, slab holding a canoe mast. 2. vs. Upright (this is said in answer to the question "pehea 'oe?'" and means "I'm fine"). Cf. *papa moe*. 3. n. A disease with severe constipation (AP) or accompanied by vomiting, back pains, belching, red eyes (*Ka Leo o ka Lahui*, Feb. 7, 1893).
- papa kuhi.kuhi.** n. Table of contents, index, schedule,
