

- directory, program, timetable. *Lit.*, pointing-out stratum. *Papa kuhikuhi i ka po'e koho*, instructions to voters.
- papa kuhi.kuhi manawa.** n. Schedule, as of ship arrivals and departures.
- papa kuhi.kuhi mea 'ai.** n. Menu, bill of fare.
- papa ku'i.** n. Jawbone, lower plate.
- papa ku'i 'ai.** n. Poi-pounding board.
- papala.** Redup. of *pala* 1. (PPN *papala*.)
- pā.pala.** 1. n. All species of a native genus (*Charpentiera*), shrubs and small trees, belonging to the amaranth family. Formerly on the north coast of Kaua'i, Hawaiians used the wood, which is light and inflammable, for fireworks, throwing burning pieces from cliffs. (Neal 332.) 2. n. Firebrand, as hurled from the cliffs in the famous Kaua'i sport, so called because *pāpala* wood was often used. *Ke ahi pāpala welo i Makua* (chant), the streaming *pāpala* firebrand at Makua. 3. nvs. Haze, fog; hoarse, as the voice. *Rare*.
- papa lā.'au.** n. Board, plank, any large wooden platter, lumber.
- pā.pā.lā.'au.** vt. To fence, to hit repeatedly with sticks.
- papa lā.'au mā.noa.noa.** n. Plank. *Lit.*, wide wooden board.
- pā.pā.laha.laha.** n. Platter (preceded by *ke*). *Lit.*, flat plate.
- pā.pala.** n. Frying pan (preceded by *ke*).
- Pā.pala-kā.'ili-'ū.** n. Name of a *lua* fighting stroke, perhaps from *pāpala kā'ili 'ula*, red snatching firebrand.
- pā.pala.keā.** n. A variety of taro.
- pā.pala.kē.pau.** n. Three native species of trees in the four-o'clock family, belonging to the genus *Pisonia*. (Neal 335.) *Lit.*, gum *pāpala*; the gum was used for bird catching. See also *āulu* 3.
- pā.pala.lē.** Redup. of *palalē* 1, 2.
- pā.pala.lī.** Redup. of *palalī*.
- papa lalo.** n. Lower floor of a house, valley bottom, lower stratum.
- pā.pala.lū.** Redup. of *palalū* 1, 2.
- pā.pala.moa.** Same as *pālāmoa*.
- papa lani.** n. Heavenly stratum, heaven and all the spiritual powers; upper regions of the air, upper heavens, firmament.
- pā.pala.ōa.** Same as *pāpala* 3. *He ao pāpalaoa no ke kuahiwi* (chant), a misty cloud for the hill.
- papa.lau.lele.** n. Small net, as for fishing in shallow water.
- pā.pala.weka.** Same as *palaweka*.
- papale.** Redup. of *pale*, to ward off. (PNP *papale*.)
- pā.pale.** nvt. Hat, head covering; crest, as of a quail; chapter on top of a column (2 Oihk. 3.15); to put on a hat, wear a hat; to overshadow. *Po'o pāpale*, crested head. *Pāpale i ka pāpale*, to put on or wear a hat. *Komo i ka pāpale*, to put on a hat [new form]. *Ua ulu kou nani ā pāpale maluna o kou kaikua'ana*, your beauty has increased so it overshadows that of your sister. (PPN *pale*.)
- pā.pale ali'i.** n. Crown.
- pā.pale hai.nikā.** n. Mitre. (Puk. 28.4.)
- pā.pā.lehu.** vt. To count by four hundred thousands, four-hundred-thousand-fold. (KL line 1773, Gram. 10.3.)
- pā.pale 'ie.** n. Hat made by plaiting a long strip, as of coconut or bamboo, which was then sewn into a hat. Some of the braids were *alahaka-o-Nu'alolo*, 'eke'eke, *iwi-puhi*, *kala hale*, *lū*, *haka-o-Hale-a-ka-lū*. *Lit.*, basket hat, so called because the narrow strip is similar to that used in making the basket 'ie.
- pā.pale kahuna.** n. Mitre, priestly hat. (Oihk. 8.9.)
- pā.pale Kale.poni.** n. Felt hat. *Lit.*, California (*Eng.*) hat.
- pā.pale kapu.** n. Cap. *Lit.*, cap (*Eng.*) hat.
- pā.pale la'a.** n. Holy crown or head covering. (Puk. 39.30.)
- papa lele kawa.** n. Springboard for diving.
- pā.pale mū.'ou.'ou.** n. Poke bonnet. *Lit.*, blunt hat.
- papa.lena.** n. Fending off, warding off, pushing aside. Cf. *papale*.
- pā.pā.leo.** Same as *pāpā'ōlelo*.
- pā.pale 'o'oma.** n. Bonnet, sunbonnet. *Lit.*, flared hat.
- pā.pale pahu.** n. Hat plaited on a *pahu pāpale*.
- pā.pale wai.okila.** n. Panama hat.
- papa lewa.lewa.** n. Net used in deep water with the *melomelo* club. *Rare*.
- papali.** n. Small cliff or slope, as along a ravine.
- papa like.** vs. Of the same species, class, rank.
- pā.pā.lima.** 1. Redup. of *pālīma* 1. 2. vs. Confirmed, as an agreement by striking hands. *ho'o.pā.pā.lima*. To touch hands as in making an agreement.
- papa lima.hana.** n. Labor board.
- papā.lina, pā.pā.lina.** n. Cheek, cheeks. See ex., *lahi-lahi* 1. *Papālina nui*, big cheeks, flabby fat flesh in general. (PEP *pa(a)paalinga*.)
- papa loio.** n. Legal profession. *Hoa o ka papa loio*, member of the bar.
- pā.pā.lole.** vs. Sluggish, indolent. *Rare*.
- papalu.** Same as *palupalu*.
- pā.palu.** nvt. Apron, covering, as to conceal nakedness; to cover. *Kui ihola lāua i nā lau piku a pa'a, i mau pā-palu no lāua* (Kin. 3.7), they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons.
- papa lua.** n. Second floor or story, second class.
- pā.pā.lua.** Redup. of *pālūa*; twice as much, very much, doubly, couple. 'Ano *pāpālūa*, dual natured. 'Ike *pā-pālūa*, to have the gift of second sight. *Kino pāpālūa*, to have a dual form, as the demigod Kama-pua'a, who could change from man to hog. *Miki pāpālūa*, to eat poi with two fingers. *Pāpālūa aku ke kolohe*, twice as much mischief. *Ua pāpālūa ka nui o kēlā ma mua o kēia*, there's twice as much of this as of that.
- papa lua hā.** n. Two by four lumber.
- Papa Luna Kia'i.** n. Board of Supervisors.
- Papa Mahi 'Ai ame Ulu Lā.'au.** n. Board of Agriculture and Forestry.
- papa mana.mana.** n. Grate, grating. *Lit.*, branching flat surface. *Papa manamana pukapuka keleawe* (Puk. 27.4), grate of network of brass.
- papa manawa.** Same as *papahola*.
- pā.pā.mano.** vt. To count by four thousands, four-thousand-fold. (KL line 1773, Gram. 10.3.)
- papa mā.noa.noa.** n. Plank.
- papa moe.** n. Horizontal stratum. *Fig.*, sick. Cf. *papakū*.
- papa.mo'i.** Same as *mo'i*.
- papa.mū.** n. 1. Stone on which the checkerlike game, *kō-nane*, was played; plaid; checkered, as gingham; checkerboard. Cf. *mū* 8. 2. A variety of taro.
- papāna.** Same as *papā*.
- papanē.** Redup. of *pane* 1.
- papani.** Redup. of *pani* 1; interception, shutting off, as from view; to block. *Holo papani ka 'eha*, the pain shuts off breath. *Ka mo'o pekēna kuli i papani i kona pepeiao* (Hal. 58.4), the deaf adder that has stopped up her ear. (PCP *papani*.)
- papa niho.** n. Row of teeth, set of teeth; jaw, bridge for false teeth.
- pā.pani.pani.** Redup. of *panipani* 1.
- papano.** Redup. of *pano*, dark.
- papa.noa.noa.** Redup. of *panoa*. *Rare*.
- papa noho.** n. Bench.
- papao.** Same as *paopao*.
- papa.'ohē.** n. Young of *akule*, a fish.
- papa 'ohi.** n. Draft board, selection board.
- papa.'oi.** Same as *ka'upu*, a fern.
- pā.pā.'ō.kole.** Same as *pāpākole*.
- Papa Ola.** n. Board of Health.
- pā.pā.'ō.lelo.** nv. To converse, talk; conversation. *E pā-pā'ōlelo kāua, 'oiai ka mana'o i 'ane'i* (chant), let's converse while the desire is here.
