- Pelei.ake, Peleiade**. n. Pleiades. (Ioba 9.9.)
- peleka**. n. 1. Also **pereka, perka**. Perch, in surveying. *Eng.* 2. Also **peleta**. Spelt (RSV), fitch (KJV). (Ezek. 4.9.) (Latin *spelta*, a species.)
- pele.kana**. n. Pelican. *Eng.*
- Pele.kane**. nvs. Britain, British, England, English, Englishman. *Eng.* 'Ōlelo *Pelekane*, English language.
- Pele.kane Nui**. n. Great Britain.
- Pele.kania, Beretania**. nvs. Britain; British. *Eng.*
- peleke**. Same as *peleki*. *Eng.*
- Pele.kepuli.kano, Pereseburitano**. nvs. Presbyterian. *Eng.*
- peleki**. nvt. Brake; to apply brakes. *Eng.* *E pa'a ana ka huila mua o ua ka'a lā mehe peleki ho'opa'a lā*, the front wheel of the car there was stopped as though stopped by brakes. **ho'o.peleki**. Caus/sim.
- Pele.kia, Peresia**. nvs. Persia; Persian. *Eng.*
- pele.kikena, peresidena**. nvs. President; presidential. *Eng.* Cf. *aupuni*.
- Pele.kiama, Belegiama**. nvs. Belgium; Belgian. *Eng.*
- pele.kona, peresona**. n. Person. *Eng.*
- pele.kunu**. n. 1. Musty, moldy, or rank odor. 2. (*Cap.*) Wet valley, north Moloka'i. See ex., *pāku'i* 3.
- pele.leu**. 1. nvs. Extended, either longitudinally or horizontally; long, broad, wide, as a nose; spreading, extending; extension, projection. See *huinakolu peleleu, huina peleleu*. *Wa'a peleleu*, a very large canoe type, sometimes a double canoe. *Kīkala peleleu*, wide, spreading hips. *I 'Inia aku nei au i ke kau 'elepani ihu peleleu* (song), I was in India riding long-trunked elephants. **ho'o.pele.leu**. To cause to spread, extend; same as above. 2. Same as *lanai*. *Rare*.
- Pele.lina, Berelina**. n. Berlin. *Eng.*
- pele.makani**. n. Propeller, as of an airplane. *Ni'ihau*.
- pelena, berena**. n. Crackers, biscuit, bread (Kin. 18.5). *Eng.* See *pa'i pelena*. *Pelena hū 'ole*, unleavened bread. *Pelena hō'ike* (Puk. 25.30), shewbread, bread of the Presence. *Pelena mo'a 'ole*, bread dough; *lit.*, uncooked bread. *'Aha'aina Pelena*, Holy Communion. *Lāpule 'Ai Pelena*, Communion Sunday.
- pelena pa'a**. n. Hardtack.
- pelē.pelē**. n. Boxing, fighting for sport. *Eng.*, *play*.
- pele.pulu**. vs. Soaked, drenched, as by rain.
- peleu**. Same as *peleleu*.
- pele.ū**. vs. Mildewed; wet, rotting, and vile-smelling, as of clothes. Cf. *pelekunu*.
- pele.ūnu**. Var. of *pelekunu*. See ex., *lohelohe* 3.
- pele.ala, feriara**. n. Friar. *Eng.*
- pele.hele, perihole**. n. Periphery. *Eng.*
- pelika, berita**. n. Covenant, bond (formerly said of matrimony). (Heb. *b'rith*.) *Pahu pelika* (Heb. 9.4), ark of the covenant. *Pale pelika* (2 Tim. 3.3), truce-breakers. *Pelika o ka mana'o'i'o*, creed, covenant of faith. *Ka pelika ma'ema'e o ka male*, the pure bonds of matrimony. *Eia ka'u pelika me lākou* (Isa. 59.21), here is my covenant with them.
- pele.kana**. n. Pelican. (Kanl. 14.17.) *Eng.*
- Pē.lina**. n. Bering. *Eng.* *Ke kai kōwā o Pēlina*, Bering Straits.
- pelio, perio**. vs. Counterfeit. *He kālā pelio ka'u*, I have counterfeit money.
- pelo**. vt. To flatter, tell tall tales, lie. (Nak. 31.) **ho'o.pelo**. Caus/sim. (PNP *pelo*.)
- peloka, peroka**. n. Perch, rod, pole. *Eng.*
- peloni, feloni**. n. Felony. *Eng.*
- pelo.pelo**. Redup. of *pelo*. **ho'o.pelo.pelo**. Caus/sim.
- pelu**. 1. vi. To fold, turn over or under, bend. Cf. *alelo pelu, pahi pelu*. *Pelu 'ia*, bent. *Pū'ao pelu*, fallen womb. *Pelu ka huelo o ka 'Ilio i ka maka'u*, the dog folded in his tail in fear. **ho'o.pelu**. To fold, turn, etc. (PPN *pelu*.) 2. nvi. A hem, tuck, as in a dress; to take a tuck, hem. *E ho'oku'u mai i ka pelu o ka lole*, let down the hem of the dress. 3. vi. To turn and go. *Pelu mai i hope*, turn back.
- pelua**. Pas/imp. of *pelu* 1-3. *Pelua ihola ka makani*, the wind turned.
- pē.lu'e**. vs. Feeble, weak. *Rare*. Cf. *lu'elu'e*.
- pelu.hā. 'ele**. n. A variety of taro.
- Pele.kia, Perusia**. nvs. Prussia; Prussian. *Eng.*
- pelu.kia 'akika, perusia asida**. n. Prussic acid. *Eng.*
- pelu.kua**. vi. To turn about; to turn and go back.
- peluli.ahi**. n. A type of *kthei* shawl dyed with sandalwood. (GP 16.)
- pelulo, berulo**. n. Beryl. (Hoik. 21.20.) (Gr. *beryllos*.)
- pelu.luka**. vs. Rotting, of crops (Malo 199, Emerson note); to soak and squeeze, as in preparing *pia*. *Rare*.
- pelu.pelu**. 1. Redup. of *pelu* 1-3. (PPN *pelupelu*.) 2. Same as *pepelu*, repetitious.
- pena**. 1. nvt. Paint; to paint. *Eng.* *Pena 'ia*, painted. 2. n. Package. *Rare*. *Pena ahipele*, package of matches. 3. vs. A Maui word for *nīele*, curious.
- pē.nā**. demon. Like that; to do or say like that. *Rare*. (Gram. 8.3.) (PPN *pehena*, PNP *peenaa*.)
- pena hale**. nv. House paint; house painter; to paint a house.
- pena ki'i**. nv. To paint pictures; picture painter; water colors.
- pena miki. 'ao**. n. Fingernail polish.
- pene**. vi. To reside a long time in one place. *Ka'ū*. Also *kūpene*. *Ua noho a ua pene i kēia wahi*, staying and living long in this place.
- penei**. demon. This way, like this, for instance, so, thus, as follows; to be thus (more definite than *pēia*). (Gram. 8.3.) *Penei ke 'ano*, like this, this way, such and such. *Pehea ke ki'ina a ka ipo? Penei iho, penei a'e, penei nō* (song), how to get a sweetheart? Thus, thus, so thus. (PPN *peheni*, PNP *pefenei*.)
- pe neia**. Same as *pe kēia* and *penei*.
- Pene.kekoka, Penetekota**. nvs. Pentecost; Pentecostal. (I Kor. 16.8.) *Eng.*
- pene.kine, benezine**. n. Benzine. *Eng.*
- pene.kū**. vi. To reside at a place for several generations.
- pene.kuina, peneguina**. n. Penguin. *Eng.*
- peni**. n. 1. Pen, pencil. *Eng.* *Maka peni*, pen point. 2. Penny. *Eng.*
- peni.kala**. n. Pencil (sometimes preceded by *ke*). *Lit.*, sharpening pen.
- peni.kenia, penitenia**. n. Sacrament of confession. (*Eng. penitence*.)
- peni.kila**. n. Painkiller. *Eng.*
- peni kila**. n. Steel pen. *Eng.*
- peno**. vt. Soaked, drenched; to soak. Cf. *penopeno, pepeno*.
- peno.peno**. Redup. of *peno*; dirty, smutty.
- penu**. vt. To sop up, as gravy; to dunk; to dab up, as tears. Cf. *pepenu*. *Mea penu 'inika*, blotter. **ho'o.penu**. To cause to sop, dunk; to dunk. (PPN *penu*.)
- penu.penu**. Redup. of *penu*. **ho'o.penu.penu**. Redup. of *ho'openu*. (PNP *penupenu*.)
- peo**. 1. n. Vagina. 2. vs. Round, globular. *Rare*.
- peo.peo**. Redup. of *peo* 2.
- pepa**. 1. nvt. Paper; card, playing cards; to play cards. *Eng.* *Pā'ani pepa*, to play cards. *'Eke pepa*, paper sack. *Lei pepa*, paper lei. *Kāwele pepa*, paper napkin or towel. *Pu'u pepa*, deck of cards. 2. n. Black or white pepper, produced from the fruit of a climbing Oriental shrub (*Piper nigrum*). (Neal 291.) *Eng.*
- pepa hahau**. n. Playing cards. *Lit.*, striking cards.
- pepa hale**. n. Wallpaper.
- pepa hā.leu**. n. Toilet paper. *Lit.*, cleansing paper.
