

piha.wēu.wēu. 1. n. Temporary bed made of dry *'ilima* branches, dried banana leaves and grasses, over which a mat or two were spread. 2. vs. Full of grass, but thin, said of a grass-eating animal that does not put on flesh.

pī.hā.wēu.wēu. n. A fish (no data).

pihe. nvi. Din of voices, crying, shouting, wailing, lamentation; to mourn, shout, etc. *Kani ka pihe*, a shout is heard. *Kū ka pihe*, a shout or lamentation arises. (PCP *pi(f,s)e.*)

pihea. Pas/imp. of *pihe*. *Ka wawā pihea a nā manu* (chant), the loud din of the birds.

pī.heka.heka. vs. Inflamed, of eyes. Cf. *heka*. *Mākole, mākole ā kahi, hele i kai o Ptheke* (chant), sore-eyed, sore-eyed as no one else, go to the sealand of Inflamed-eye [Kama-pua'a taunts the goddess Pele].

pī.heka.heka. Redup. of *piheka*.

pī.hele.hele. vs. Grated, mashed, pulverized; to grate.

pihi. 1. n. Scab, scar. 2. n. Button, badge; to button (preceded by *ke*). Cf. *huka pihi, pihi pūlima. Pihi māka'i*, police badge. *Pihi 'āmi'i*, snap fastener. (PCP *pi(f,s)i*; cf. Marquesan *pihi.*) 3. vs. Blunt, dull, as a wooden digging stick. *Rare*. 4. n. Fish. *Eng. Ua loa'a mai ka pihi nui* (song), got the big fish.

pihi.pihi. 1. Redup. of *pihi 1*; scarred. 2. Redup. of *pihi 2*; any small objects shaped like buttons, as washers (preceded by *ke*). 3. nvt. To skip stones on the surface of the water; stone skipping. 4. Redup. of *pihi 3*. *Rare*.

pihi pū.lima. n. Cuff button.

pihō. 1. nvs. Swamp, mire; swampy. 2. Var. of *piholo*, to swamp, as a canoe. (For. 5:541.) **ho'o.pihō.** Caus/sim.

pihoa. Dizzy. (And.)

pī.hō.hō. Same as *pihōpihō*.

pī.hohono. Same as *'auko'i*, a plant.

pī.hoi. Same as *pīhoihoi*.

pī.hoi.hoi. nvs. Disturbed, excited, worried, agitated, alarmed, perturbed, upset, uneasy, astonished, emotional; worry, anxiety, astonishment. (Dan. 5.6.) *Hana pīhoihoi*, exciting event, adventure. *Ka pīhoihoi o ka na'au* (Kanl. 28.28), astonishment of heart. **ho'o.pī.hoi.hoi.** To cause anxiety; to worry, excite, astonish.

pī.hole. vi. To fidget, as a child; to paw, as a drunk; to squirm, flirtatiously sidle up to a man; restless.

piholo. vi. To sink, founder, drown, be swamped, shipwrecked. **ho'o.piholo.** To sink, drown.

pī.holo.holo. 1. Redup. of *piholo*. 2. vs. Watery, as poi. *Rare*.

pī.hopa, bihopa. nvs. Bishop; Episcopalian. *Eng. Ho'o-mana Pihopa*, Episcopalian religion.

pihō.pihō. Redup. of *pihō*; to bob up and down or swamp, as a canoe.

pihulu. vs. Hairy, fuzzy. *'Eki pihulu*, ace of spades.

pi'i. 1. vi. To go inland or overland (whether or not uphill), to go or walk up, climb, ascend, advance, mount, rise; to grow up, as a child; to fall, as one shadow on another. See *ihu pi'i*. *Pi'i kuahiwi*, mountain climber; to climb mountains. *Pi'i ke kai*, the sea rises [the temper flares]. *Malo'o ka wai, pi'i ka lepo*, the water dries up, the dirt comes up [reasoning and understanding are gone, only invective is left]. **ho'o.pi'i.** To cause to rise, promote, mount, come up, raise up, bring forth, utter; to turn into the wind; promotion. See ex., *limalima 4*. *Me ka ho'opi'i aku ma ka inoa o kō kākou Haku*, and call forth the name of our Lord. (PEP *piki.*) 2. vi. To experience personally, or appear, as heat, cold, emotion. See ex., *mane'o*. *Hānau ka pi'i 'awa'awa, he 'awa'awa kona* (KL line 520), are born those of bitter disposition, theirs is bitterness. *No kona huhū, pi'i ka 'ōlelo 'ino*, because of his anger, evil words come forth. *Ke pi'i nei ka mana'o*, the idea comes now. *Pi'i ka makemake*, the desire comes. *Pi'i ke anu*, to get chills. *Pi'i ka huhū, pi'i ka 'ena, pi'i ka heu*, to get very angry, heated, bristling. *Pi'i ka wela*, to get a fever; to feel the heat of anger. *Pi'i ka 'ōhune wela*, to get prickly heat. *Pi'i ka 'ula*, to blush. **ho'o.pi'i.** Same as *ho'opi'ipi'i*. 3. Same as *pi'ipi'i 3*, curly. (PEP *piki.*) 4. Same as *pipi'i*, expensive. 5. nvt. Intercourse; to practice inter-

course; to mount, as of male animals. **ho'o.pi'i.** To cause to mount, as of male animals; to breed, impregnate. 6. n. Triangular piece inserted in a *holokū* skirt to add width, or inserted at the base of the legs of bell-bottom trousers. (PPN *piki.*) 7. n. Taros. See below.

-pi'i. ho'o.pi'i. To sue (see ex., *mālama ola*), bring suit, bring a complaint to one in authority, accuse in court, prosecute, petition; appeal, lawsuit, court case, petition. Cf. *palapala ho'opi'i. Mea i ho'opi'i 'ia*, accused. *Ho'opi'i 'āina*, to have a suit over land matters. *Po'e (mea) ho'opi'i*, plaintiff. *Po'e (mea) ho'opi'i 'ia*, defendant, accused party. *Ho'opi'i pohō*, suit for damages.

pi'ia. Pas/imp. of *pi'i 1*. *Ke āhua i pi'ia e ke keiki*, the mound climbed by the child.

pi'i.ali'i. n. A native variety of taro, one of the oldest varieties grown in Hawai'i; formerly known as one of the royal taros and desirable as an offering to the gods; today, an important wet-land poi taro. Leaves and corm are tinged with pink. (HP 28, Whitney.) This name may be qualified by the colors *'ele'ele, ke'oke'o, 'ula'ula*. See ex., *hanao*.

pi'i ali'i. v. To claim chiefly blood, whether or not it exists. **ho'o.pi'i ali'i.** Caus/sim.

pi'i.hā.lā.wai. n. A variety of taro. (HP 34.)

pi'i kea. vi. To become light, as the day; to begin to gray, of hair.

pi'i.koi. vt. To claim honors not rightfully due, to seek preferment, to aspire to the best or to more than is one's due; to claim to be of higher rank than one is. See ex., *loa'a . . . kāu. Mai pi'ikoi i ka 'ama'ama*, don't strive for the *'ama'ama* [this fish was very choice; the meaning is: be satisfied with what you have, why aim for the moon].

pi'i.kū. 1. nvi. To climb a steep slope; to climb, as a coconut palm by grasping the trunk with the hands and walking up with the feet; a steep climb. 2. n. A medicine made of the sap of young *kukui* nuts, used as a gargle for sore throat and thrush; if swallowed it causes nausea and looseness of the bowels. 3. n. Transpiration, water drops on leaves of plants. *Rare*. Cf. *wai hua*.

pi'i.kuma. n. A type of ancient prayer. (For. 6:23.)

pi'i.lae. vs. Haughty, proud. *Lit.*, forehead rising. *Rare*.

pi'ina. n. Climb, ascent, rise, incline, etc. Cf. *pi'i 1*. **ho'o.pi'ina (a)** Same as above. **(b)** Quilting in a direction away from the quilter. Also *ho'opi'ipi'i*. (PEP *pikinga.*)

pi'i pā.walu. n. Octave. *Lit.*, eightfold ascent.

pi'i.pi'i. 1. Redup. of *pi'i 1*; bubbling forth, as water (Kanl. 8.7); to overflow, as charged water; effervesce. *Wai pi'ipi'i*, charged water or liquid. *Pi'ipi'i akula nā 'ale* (Hal. 107.25), lifting the waves up [of a wind]. **ho'o.pi'i.pi'i. (a)** Redup. of *ho'opi'i*; to sail, beat, or tack against the wind; to regurgitate. *Lā'au ho'opi'ipi'i*, emetic, medicine to cause vomiting. **(b)** Same as *ho'opi'ina (b)*. (PCP *pikipiki.*) 2. Redup. of *pi'i 2*. Cf. *pi'ipi'i kai, pi'ipi'i 'ōlelo. ho'o.pi'i.pi'i.* To stir up ill feelings, to rouse anger; jealousy. 3. vs. Curly, curled, wavy. *Pi'ipi'i lau nui*, wavy, of hair. *Pi'ipi'i Pukikī*, kinky, of hair. (PEP *pikipiki.*) 4. Same as *pipi'i*, expensive. 5. Redup. of *pi'i 5*. 6. Same as *mānienie 'ula*, a grass.

pi'i.pi'i ali'i. Redup. of *pi'iali'i*.

pi'i.pi'i kai. vi. To rise, of a strong sea. *Fig.*, to flare, as anger.

pi'i.pi'i.lau.mana.mana. Same as *'anali'i*, a fern.

pi'i.pi'i 'ō.lelo. n. Words of anger, emotion, controversy. **ho'o.pi'i.pi'i 'ō.lelo.** To cause controversy, words of anger, etc.

pika. 1. n. Short for *pīka'o 2*. *Rare*. 2. n. Pitcher (*Eng.*), vase. 3. n. Beet (*Beta vulgaris*). (Neal 331.) *Eng.* 4. n. Picul; half. *Eng.* 5. vs. Hot, as peppery food (said in pidgin *Eng.*).

pī kai. v. To sprinkle with sea water or salted fresh water to purify or remove taboo, as formerly done after a
